Finally, let us pray for one another, for all those we love, and for all who have not yet heard or accepted new and lasting hope in Christ our risen Lord.

Drogie Siostry i drodzy Bracia w Zmartwychwstałym Panu,

W okresie wielkanocnym świętujemy zmartwychwstanie Chrystusa, naszej nadziei oraz głosimy, że On żyje w Kościele. W obliczu wielu wyzwań, z jakimi obecnie boryka się świat, to On jest naszą nadzieją.

Pomyśl o naszych siostrach i braciach na Ukrainie, a także o ludziach w innych częściach świata, którzy codziennie zmagają się z wojną, niepokojami społecznymi, przemocą, represjami i klęskami żywiołowymi. Pomyśl o tych, którzy są bezdomni i tych, którzy chodzą naszymi ulicami, pomyśl też o tych, których ulice w naszym mieście tyranizowane są przemocą. Pomyśl również o mocach ciemności, które wciąż polaryzują nasze społeczeństwo przyczyniając się do wzrostu grzeszności, a także o cierpieniu tak wielu osób z przewlekłymi chorobami umysłowymi lub fizycznymi. Pamiętając o tym wszystkim, jasno widzimy, że potrzebujemy zmartwychwstałego Chrystusa, który jest naszą nadzieją.

Zachęcam Was do odnowienia wielkanocnej wiary i nadziei w Chrystusa szczególnie, kiedy zgromadzeni ze swoją wspólnotą parafialną kolejny raz w życiu usłyszycie radosne „Chrystus zmartwychwstał”. W odpowiedzi zaśpiewamy „Alleluja! Prawdziwie zmartwychwstał”. Wyrazimy tymi słowami, że słysząc dobrą nowinę coraz bardziej wierzymy, że przez powstanie z grobu, Chrystus zerwał więzy grzechu i śmierci, że uznał nas za swoje własne córki i synów światłości.

My dear Parishioners, Brothers and Sisters,

Resurrection! Only one word and so many meanings. We celebrate the Resurrection in March or April, on Sunday, after the first spring full moon. And it is usually a spring time. Oh yes, I know ... I know that sometimes the weather surprises us in different ways, but usually it is a spring time. Everything comes to life. Exactly – **TO LIFE!**

And this is what happens during Easter. We are coming back to life. I will say even more – we feel immortal! We all want immortality, but so far only one Person in human history has experienced it, overcoming death. It was Jesus Christ. Resurrection is the most amazing event in the history of the world and our Christian faith is based on it. Paul teaches: "And if Christ has not been raised, then empty too is our preaching; empty, too, your faith." (1 Corinthians 15,14).

No wonder the apostles hardly believed in the words of Mary Magdalene and other women who came running from the grave to tell the disciples that the Lord was resurrected. St. Luke in his Gospel writes: "but their story seemed like nonsense and they did not believe them" (Lk 24,11). Probably we would react similarly. It may be that we believe in the resurrection of Jesus in our mind, but we still do not believe in our hearts.

Is it joyful to think that in the day of glory we will rise from the dead and live with eternal happiness with Jesus Christ? This is what we celebrate during Easter. This is our faith.

In this sacred time, I would like to thank all of you for your kindness and the material help that you show to our parish. Sacred Heart Parish is **OUR** parish. We are responsible for it. That is why, while I'm thanking you, I dare to ask you to remember also to support our parish in this joyous Easter time. I am very grateful for your help and generosity because I know your great concern for the material future of our parish. For all your donations may the Risen Christ reward you hundredfold!

On behalf of all the priests and the parish staff I wish you a great, happy, and healthy Easter. When Jesus Christ met the Apostles after His resurrection, He greeted them with these words: **Peace be with you!** May God's peace be firmly established in your hearts and in your families, homes, in our parish, in the United States, and in the whole world, especially in Ukraine! May the Risen Lord bless you and your families!

Moi Drodzy Parafianie, Siostry i Bracia,

Zmartwychwstanie! Jedno słowo, a tak wiele znaczeń. Święta Zmartwychwstania Pańskiego obchodzimy w marcu lub kwietniu, w niedzielę, po pierwszej wiosennej pełni księżyca. I jest to zwykle czas bardzo wiosenny. Tak wiem, że czasem pogoda sprawia nam różne niespodzianki, ale zwykle jest to czas wiosny. Wszystko budzi się do życia. Właśnie – **DO ŻYCIA!**

I to właśnie się dzieje w czasie świąt Wielkanocnych.

Wracamy do życia. Powiem więcej czujemy się nieśmiertelni. Jedno z najgłębszych pragnień ludzkiego serca to wieczna młodość, dlatego wiele kultur w ciągu wieków miało wyobrażenie eliksiru młodości – lekarstwa, które zapewni nieśmiertelność. Może dlatego jednym z najbardziej popularnych produktów kosmetycznych są kremy, które mają spowolnić proces starzenia się.

Wszyscy pragniemy nieśmiertelności, ale do tej pory tylko jedna Osoba w historii ludzkości doświadczyła jej, zwyciężając śmierć – Jezus Chrystus! Zmartwychwstanie jest najbardziej zdumiewającym wydarzeniem w historii świata i na tym właśnie wydarzeniu opiera się nasza chrześcijańska wiara. Paweł naucza: „Jeśli Chrystus nie zmartwychwstał, daremne jest nasze nauczanie, próżna jest także wasza wiara” (1 Kor 15,14).

Nic dziwnego, że apostołowie z trudem wierzyli Marii Magdalenie i innym kobietom, które przybiegły od grobu, by powiedzieć uczniom, że Pan zmartwychwstał. Ewangelista Łukasz pisze: „Lecz słowa te wydały im się częstą gadaniną i nie dali im wiary” (Łk 24,11). Pewnie na miejscu apostołów zareagowalibyśmy podobnie. Być może jest tak, że wierzymy w zmartwychwstanie Jezusa rozumem, ale ciągle jeszcze nie wierzymy naszymi sercami.

Czy sprawia nam radość myśl, że w dniu chwały powstaniemy z martwych i razem z Nim będziemy żyć w wiecznym szczęściu? To właśnie świętujemy w czasie Wielkanocy. To jest nasza wiara!

W tym świętym czasie chciałbym Wam podziękować za troskę o naszą parafię. Parafia Najświętszego Serca jest **NASZĄ** parafią. Jesteśmy za nią odpowiedzialni. Dziękując za Wasze hojne serca ośmielam się nadal prosić o materialne wspieranie parafii Serca Pana Jezusa w Palos Hills. Za każde Wasze wsparcie niech Zmartwychwstały Chrystus nagrodzi Was stokrotnie swoim błogosławieństwem!

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Join Us for Divine Mercy Sunday, April 16, 2023

Sacred Heart will have a special Holy Hour for the “Feast of Mercy” on Sunday, April 16th.

The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of St. Faustina Kowalska from Poland. Our Lord appeared to Sister Faustina Kowalska in a vision, who told her to paint the now famous image of Divine Mercy, and requested that the Feast of Mercy be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. St. Faustina was the first saint canonized by Pope John Paul II in the new millennium (Fr. McGinnity attended the beautiful event in Rome).

The Sacred Heart Queen of Peace prayer group will be sponsoring a Holy Hour on the Feast of Mercy again this year at the parish. The preparations **began on Good Friday, April 7th**, with the special Divine Mercy novena – red novena prayer cards can be found at the back of church. Please pray the novena for 9 days to obtain mercy for yourselves and for the whole world, ending with the Feast Day on Sunday. The Lord promised special graces to all who keep this special Feast of Mercy: “The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion **shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment**. On that day are open all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet.”

At this time in the world of unrest, let us pray to have peace and mercy.

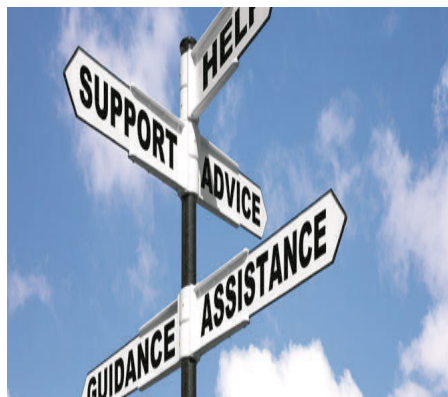


Food Collection Next Weekend

Last month's food donations weren't where we had hoped they'd be. We ended up -28% vs. March 2022 (569 lbs. vs. 789 lbs.). But, if you look at the aggregate, we're +21% YTD. And because we love data, Elsie's Pantry began sharing the number of the people they serve each week. The demand is very real and it isn't subsiding. These are our neighbors; sisters and brothers in Christ. They're not on the other side of the globe. They are right here in Palos Township. And that's where we focus our efforts. So, we ask that you keep us in mind next weekend (**April 15-16**) as we conduct our next food drive.

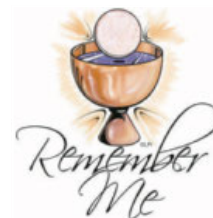
Counseling By Fr. Rohrich

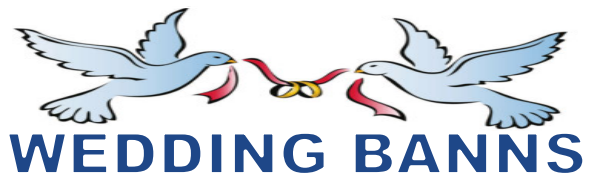
