

Drogie Siostry i drodzy Bracia w Chrystusie,

Dzień Matki to czas poświęcony pamięci wszystkich matek i osób, które w naszym życiu pełnią rolę matek - kobiet, które nas karmiły, pielęgnowały, uczyły i podtrzymywały w trudnościach. Matki są niezastąpione w każdym pokoleniu, w każdym momencie naszego dnia, w wypełnianiu indywidualnie oraz wspólnotowo Bożego planu.

Okazywanie wsparcia matkom w potrzebach jest podstawą naszej wiary, a pomaganie matkom jest głównym powołaniem i zadaniem Katolickiej Organizacji Charytatywnej Caritas (Catholic Charities). 

#### CLIMATE CHANGE: A MATTER OF FAITH? YES.

Following John Paul II and Benedict, Pope Francis recognizes the scientific consensus that most of the current warming trends are caused by human activity. Deforestation and burning fossil fuels are major causes. While some have wrongly turned it into a political issue, Pope Francis recognizes it as a social justice and a moral issue. This is because those who will suffer most from the resulting environmental damage are the poor and future generations...who are least responsible for causing it. Francis calls upon individuals, governments and corporations to make changes to mitigate the problem. He has met with top energy company executives and they have agreed to support policies that put a price on carbon emissions. The US Conference of Catholic Bishops also has issued a statement of past support for legislation that puts a price on carbon emissions to encourage a switch to clean energy, without economically harming the poor or middle class. The severe human costs, that will be a consequence of doing nothing, make this a moral issue and a matter of concern and action as part of our faith.


