Last month, you generously donated 509 lbs. of food. Even though it was our lowest collection of the year, it still made an impact. When we delivered our donations to Elsie's Pantry, we were shocked to see their shelves and refrigerators practically empty. Easter contributed to in uptick in demand for them. Thankfully, our donations helped bridge the gap until their next significant food delivery from the USDA (which is precisely why we moved our collections to the 3rd weekends of the month). At the same time, Elsie's demand continues to average 268 people per week. So, keep us in mind next week (May 20-21) as we conduct our next food collection.

Note: We are no longer accepting monetary donations. While we appreciate every donation to assist our sisters and brothers in need, the monetary donations were taking away from the original mission of this ministry...providing nourishment.

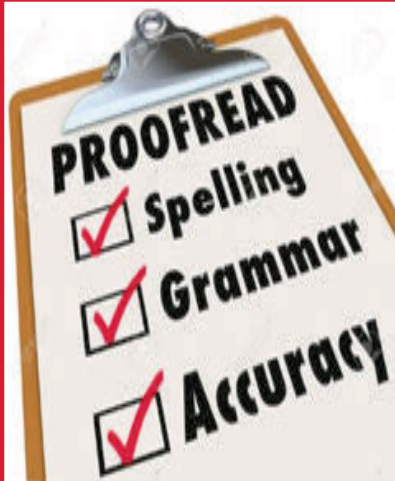

Trees also absorb the CO₂ that contributes to global warming and release oxygen back into the air. In one year, an acre of mature trees absorbs the amount of CO₂ produced by a car driven 26,000 miles.

Planting trees also helps prevent soil erosion, increases land fertility and can add value to your property. Trees that provide shade can also significantly reduce your energy bills. When selecting trees, choose native types to support local wildlife. Spring and fall can be good times to plant.

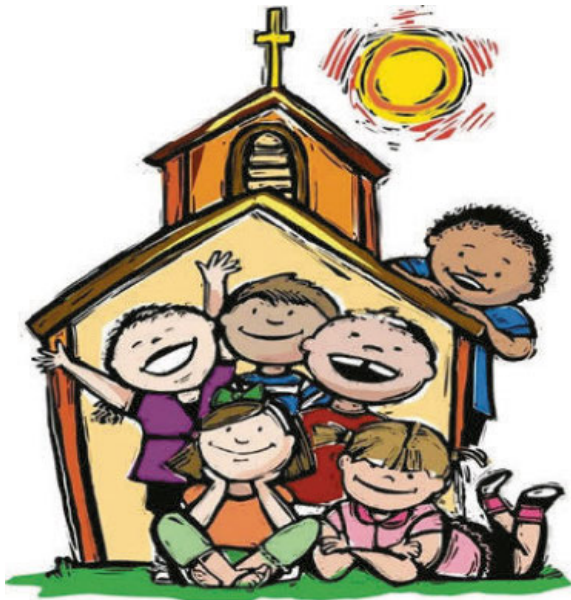
