

My dear Parishioners, Brothers and Sisters,



The Feast of the Ascension is a day on which we look up to heaven. We try to see if it really exists. Very often we are like the apostles, who are looking up at the sky. Ascension Day describes what it means to be a Christian very well. We ask: How do we reconcile the matter of God and earthly affairs? Is there really a conflict? Someone asked: But, I have a job, I have to work hard because of my family. So, I don't have time to pray. I'm

so busy, so tired. In his spiritual work, Introduction to the Devout Life (known as "Philothea"), St. Francis de Sales left us with one of the best answers to these problems. He wrote that each of us can live our life and that this life can be holy. Also, he wrote that it is obvious that someone who has a family must care for it and cannot live like a monk. While someone who has devoted his life to God can't live only with the issues of the world. Therefore, each of us has his personal path to holiness. And on this path, he can be a Christian. That is what the Ascension is telling us. A Christian is someone who is down on earth but is also aware that life does not end with death. Therefore, he continues to look up. Despite the variety of jobs, things we need to do, we can find time for even a short prayer. We now look up to heaven, looking for Jesus, and He still assures us; I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.

The month of May is almost over. Next Saturday, May 27th at 4:30pm Mass we will celebrate 50 years of Fr. Robert Rohrich service to Sacred Heart. We are very grateful to God for those years and we continue to pray for Fr. Bob.

June 3, 2023, marks my 27th anniversary of ordination to the Priesthood! It has been a profound privilege far beyond what words can describe. Even though sometimes there are stormy clouds in my journey, I have the best job in the world and the most joy-filled life I could imagine. I love being a priest and remain deeply grateful to God for His call.

During the past 27 years, I have had the privilege of serving in various ways. I ministered for three years as the Associate Pastor of St. Catherine Parish in Grybow, Poland. In 2002 I took my Doctorate at the St. John Paul II Catholic University in Lublin, in the field of homiletics. Soon after that in September 2002, I came to United States. I worked in St. Constance Parish in Chicago for five years and in St. Theresa Parish in Palatine for two years. In 2013-2016 I was a rector of Abramowicz Seminary. And in 2016 I came to Sacred Heart Parish in Palos Hills.

As many of you witnessed throughout the years, I navigated our Parish through stormy weather that came our way, especially at the Pandemic. Then we safely walked together through a challenging and complex time of Renew My Church, In the meantime i.a. I strengthened parish finances, and beautified our Parish on every single level, from spiritual to physical. That required much energy.

To keep priests refreshed and vibrant, our Archdiocesan Policy states that every eight years or so, priests may apply for a full six-month sabbatical that consists of rest, educational advancement, and spiritual refreshment. The sabbatical is an intentional effort to nurture my vocation, and I can't wait to see what the following years of the priesthood may bring!

During the Fall of 2022, I began a formal process with the Priests' Sabbatical Board and Cardinal Cupich regarding my desire for just that: a little rest, personal spiritual renewal, and the need to spend some time with my elderly parents (on April 29th my father celebrated his 91st birthday) and my sister and her family overseas.

Cardinal Cupich, following the recommendation of the Priests' Sabbatical Board and Bishop Andrew Wypych, approved my request for six months of sabbatical that will begin in mid July 2023. In his letter dated December 12, 2022, Cardinal Cupich stated: "This appointment is made with gratitude for your service in your present assignment and with the understanding that you will return to your position as Pastor at Sacred Heart Parish in Palos Hills. Thank you for your fine work at Sacred Heart Parish and for your 27 years of service to the People of God. You are in my prayers, and I ask that you please keep me in yours."

During my sabbatical, my Associate Fr. Jarosław Maciejewski will be the Administrator of Sacred Heart Parish until my return at the beginning of January 2024. Fr. Jarek knows my vision well and is familiar with my style of leadership and the future goals that I have set on the horizon for our Parish. I am grateful and confident that he will be guiding the parish during my six-month absence with the help and support of our staff. I'm grateful to him for saying 'yes' to administering the Parish during my absence.

I share this news with you today, on the Feast of the Ascension and very close to the Anniversary of my Ordination. I also share this news with you so that you might pray for me during my absence in the Parish. I thank my staff for all their support and willingness to help Fr. Jarek during my sabbatical. Thank you for your ongoing prayers and support. I will continue praying for you.

Drodzy Parafianie, Bracia i Siostry,



Święto Wniebowstąpienia to dzień, w którym spoglądamy w niebo, tak jak Apostołowie. Dzień Wniebowstąpienia bardzo dobrze opisuje, co to znaczy być chrześcijaninem. Pytamy: Jak pogodzić sprawy Boże ze sprawami ziemskimi? Czy naprawdę istnieje taki konflikt? Mówicie: "ale ja mam pracę, muszę ciężko pracować ze względu na rodzinę. Nie mam więc czasu na modlitwę. Jestem taki zajęty,

taki zmęczony." W swoim dziele Wprowadzenie do życia pobożnego (znanym jako Filotea) św. Franciszek Salezy pozostawił nam jedną z najlepszych odpowiedzi na te problemy. Napisał, że każdy z nas może żyć swoim życiem i że to życie może być święte! Napisał też, że to oczywiste, że ktoś, kto ma rodzinę, musi o nią dbać i nie może żyć jak mnich. Podczas gdy ktoś, kto poświęcił swoje życie Bogu, nie może żyć tylko problemami tego świata. Dlatego każdy z nas ma swoją osobistą drogę do świętości. To właśnie mówi nam Wniebowstąpienie. Chrześcijanin to ktoś, kto twardo stąpa po ziemi, ale ma też świadomość, że życie nie kończy się wraz ze śmiercią. Dlatego nadal patrzy w górę. Mimo różnorodności zajęć, które mamy do wykonania, znajdźmy czas nawet na krótką modlitwę. Patrzymy teraz w niebo, szukając Jezusa, a On wciąż nas zapewnia: **Ja jestem z wami zawsze, aż do skończenia świata.**

Miesiąc maj powoli dobiega końca. W najbliższą sobotę 27 maja podczas Mszy Św. o godz. 4:30 będziemy obchodzić 50-lecie pracy ks. Roberta Rohricha w naszej parafii. Jesteśmy bardzo wdzięczni Bogu za lata jego pracy i nadal polecam ks. Rohricha Waszej modlitwie.

3 czerwca 2023 r. przypada 27-ma rocznica moich święceń kapłańskich. Choć czasem na tej drodze pojawiają się burzowe chmury, to wciąż chciałbym Wam i innym wiernym służyć jak najlepiej, pozostając głęboko wdzięczny Bogu za Jego powołanie.

W ciągu ostatnich 27 lat pracowałem w różnych miejscach. Przez trzy lata byłem wikariuszem parafii św. Katarzyny w Grybowie. W 2002 roku obroniłem doktorat na Katolickim Uniwersytecie Lubelskim św. Jana Pawła II w dziedzinie homiletyki. Wkrótce potem we wrześniu 2002 roku przyjechałem do Stanów Zjednoczonych. Przez pięć lat pracowałam w parafii św. Konstancji w Chicago, a przez dwa lata w parafii św. Teresy w Palatine. W latach 2013-2016 byłem rektorem Seminarium Duchownego im. Bpa Abramowicza. A w 2016 roku zostałem proboszczem parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa w Palos Hills.

Razem przeżywaliśmy różne chwile w tych latach, były dni radosne i trochę trudne, czy nawet niezrozumiałe, zwłaszcza podczas pandemii. Bezpiecznie przeszliśmy razem przez trudny i złożony czas procesu Renew My Church (Odnów Mój Kościół). W tym czasie m.in. wzmocniły się finanse naszej parafii. Teren naszej parafii pięknieje na każdym poziomie, od duchowego do fizycznego. A to wymagało sporo energii i pracy.

Aby pomóc kapłanom Archidiecezja Chicago zaleca i pomaga, aby mniej więcej co osiem lat księża ubiegali się o pełny sześciomiesięczny urlop naukowy, który obejmuje odpoczynek, postęp w nauce i duchowe odnowienie (Sabbatical).

Jesienią 2022 roku złożyłem prośbę o pozwolenie na urlop sabatyczny i wraz z Radą Personalną Księży i kardynałem Cupichem rozpocząłem proces przygotowania programu takiego urlopu.

Kardynał Cupich, kierując się rekomendacją Kapłańskiej Rady Personalnej i Ks. Biskupa Andrzeja Wypycha, zatwierdził moją prośbę o sześciomiesięczny urlop naukowy, który rozpocznie się w połowie lipca 2023 r. W liście z dnia 12 grudnia 2022 r. Kardynał Cupich stwierdził: "Ta nominacja została dokonana z wdzięcznością za Twoją służbę na obecnym stanowisku i ze zrozumieniem, że powrócisz na swoje stanowisko proboszcza w parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa w Palos Hills. Dziękuję za Twoją dotychczasową wspaniałą pracę w Parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa i za 27 lat służby Ludowi Bożemu. Jesteś w moich modlitwach i proszę, abyś modlił się także za mnie".

Podczas mojego urlopu ks. Jarosław Maciejewski będzie Administratorem parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa do mojego powrotu na początku stycznia 2024 r. Ks. Jarek dobrze zna moją wizję parafii oraz przyszłe cele, które postawiłem na horyzoncie dla naszej Parafii. Jestem przekonany, że dobrze będzie kierował parafią podczas mojej sześciomiesięcznej nieobecności. Jestem mu wdzięczny za to, że zgodził się zarządzać parafią podczas mojej nieobecności.

Dzielę się z Wami tą wiadomością dzisiaj, w uroczystość Wniebowstąpienia Pańskiego, bardzo blisko rocznicy moich święceń kapłańskich. Dzielę się również z Wami tą wiadomością, abyście modlili się za mnie podczas mojej nieobecności w Parafii. Za wszystko dziękuję moim pracownikom oraz za ich pomoc ks. Jarkowi. Dziękuję za Wasze nieustające modlitwy i wsparcie. Jesteście codziennie w moich modlitwach.



Celebrating the Anniversary of Pope Francis' transformational encyclical, Laudato Si'

"Care for Creation" and Laudato Si' (Part I)

- The Pope's encyclical, Laudato Si', is a text of landmark significance in Catholic Social Teaching.
- Francis, like his thirteenth-century namesake, calls the earth our "common home," which is like our sister.
- But we are damaging this familial relationship as we seriously degrade the environment. In so doing, we are damaging our relationship with other humans, particularly those least equipped to adjust to the changing environment: the poor and future generations.
- The Pope encourages people to examine and change their lifestyles through sound ecological virtues, greater simplicity and less focus on material things.
- Francis extends an "urgent challenge to protect our common home ... to bring the whole human family together to seek a sustainable and integral development, for we know that things can change."
- By taking personal action and reducing excessive consumption and waste in our lives, we can meet our obligation to reduce our impact on the environment while creating a sustainable future for generations to follow.
