My Dear Parishioners, Brothers and Sisters,

As you know in April 2008, Pope Benedict XVI visited the USA. During his visit, the Holy Father told us:

America is a land of great faith. People are remarkable for their religious fervor and they take pride in belonging to a worshipping community.

Freedom is not only a gift, but also a summons to personal responsibility. Americans know this from experience — almost every town in this country has its monuments honoring those who sacrificed their lives in defense of freedom, both at home and abroad. The preservation of freedom calls for the cultivation of virtue, self-discipline, sacrifice for the common good and a sense of responsibility towards the less fortunate. It also demands the courage to engage in civic life and to bring one's deepest beliefs and values to reasoned public debate. In a word, freedom is ever new. It is a challenge held out to each generation, and it must constantly be won over for the cause of good (cf. Spe Salvi, 24). Few have understood this as clearly as the late Pope John Paul II. In reflecting on the spiritual victory of freedom over communism in his native Poland and in eastern Europe, he reminded us that history shows, time and again, that "in a world without truth, freedom loses its foundation", and a democracy without values can lose its very soul (cf. Centesimus Annus, 46).

These words are very important for us. The Holy Fathers told us that we are a nation of great faith, and he reminded us that freedom is not only a gift but also a responsibility. And so these words are like a personal task for us, for our community, for our nation.

Let's pray for United States of America:

Dear Lord, There is no greater feeling of liberation than to experience this freedom from sin and death that you have provided for us through Jesus Christ. Today our hearts and our souls are free to praise you. For this we are very thankful. On this Independence Day we are reminded of all those who have sacrificed for are freedom. Help us to live our lives in a way that glorifies you, Lord. Give us the strength to be a blessing in someone else's life today, and grant us the opportunity to lead others into the freedom that can be found in knowing You, our God. We ask this trough Christ our Lord. Amen.

I wish you all a wonderful Sunday rest and a great week. I remember you in my everyday prayers and I ask you to pray for me too, please. May God reward you all the good that you do for Sacred Heart Parish.

Drodzy Parafianie, Siostry i Bracia,

W 2008 roku Ojciec Święty Benedykt XVI w czasie wizyty w Stanach Zjednoczonych Ameryki, powiedział takie słowa:

Ameryka jest ziemią wielkiej wiary. Mieszkańcy Ameryki to ludzie znani ze swojej gorliwej religijności i dumy z przynależenia do wspólnot religijnych. (...)

Wolność jest nie tylko darem, ale także wezwaniem do odpowiedzialności osobistej. Amerykanie znają to z doświadczenia - niemal każde miasto w tym kraju posiada pomniki upamiętniające tych, którzy złożyli swoje życie w ofierze, broniąc wolności, zarówno w kraju, jak i za granicą. Zachowanie wolności wzywa do uprawiania cnoty, samodyscypliny, ofiarności na rzecz dobra wspólnego oraz poczucia odpowiedzialności w stosunku do mniej szczęśliwych. Wymaga także odwagi zaangażowania się w życiu publicznym i wniesienia własnych najgłębszych przekonań i wartości do rozumnej debaty publicznej. Krótko mówiąc, wolność jest zawsze nowa. Jest wyzwaniem, które staje przed każdym pokoleniem i musi stale być zdobywana ze względu na dobro (por. Spe Salvi, 24). Niewiele osób rozumiało to tak jasno, jak Papież Jan Paweł II. Mówiąc o duchowym zwycięstwie nad komunizmem w Polsce oraz w Europie Wschodniej, przypominał, że historia wciąż nam przypomina, że "w świecie pozbawionym prawdy, wolność traci swój fundament", a demokracja bez wartości traci swoją duszę. (Centesimus Annus, 46).

Te słowa są dla nas bardzo ważne. Bardzo często Stany Zjednoczone nazywane są czy też były nazywane narodem wielkiej wiary, a śp. Papież Benedykt przypominał, że wolność to nie tylko dar, ale i odpowiedzialność. A więc te słowa są jak osobiste zadanie dla nas, dla naszej społeczności, dla naszego narodu.

W ten Dzień Niepodległości wspominamy z wdzięcznością wszystkich, którzy poświęcili swoje życie dla wolności. Pomóż nam żyć w taki sposób, aby nieustannie oddawać Ci chwałę Panie. Daj nam siłę, aby także nasze życie było błogosławieństwem dla kogoś i pomóż nam prowadzić innych ku wolności, którą prawdziwie można znaleźć jedynie w poznaniu Ciebie, nasz Boże. Prosimy o to przez Chrystusa Pana naszego. Amen.



### **Laundry Energy Saving Tips**

There are two ways to reduce the amount of energy used for washing clothes—use less water and use cooler water. Unless you're dealing with oily stains, the warm or cold water setting on your machine will generally do a good job of cleaning your clothes. Switching your temperature setting from hot to warm can cut a load's energy use in half.

- Wash your clothes in cold water using cold-water detergents whenever possible.
- Wash and dry full loads. If you are washing a small load, use the appropriate water-level setting.
- Dry towels and heavier cottons in a separate load from lighter-weight clothes.
- Don't over-dry your clothes. If your machine has a moisture sensor, use it.


