



Missionary Co-op For This Weekend

Rev. Fr. Joyanto Sylvester Gomes was born on September23,1960 and finished his degree level studies from Notre Dame College, in Dhaka. He was ordained a priest on December 27, 1988. Later, he received a Masters in Mass Communication from the University of Ateneo De Manila. He has been serving as a parish priest in a large parish in Dhaka. He has worked in different capacities for example: formation in the Minor Seminary, head of the Christian Social Communication Centre and Coordinator of Radio Veritas. He is a very responsible, hardworking and a dedicated priest in the Archdiocese.

Bangladesh has a total population of 168 million people. About 90% of the population is Muslim, a small percentage are Hindu and Buddhist, and less than 1% of people are Christian. There are eight Dioceses in Bangladesh. Dhaka is a major city. More than 20 million people live in Dhaka, and it is one of the most densely populated and most polluted cities in the world. There are many poor people who live in the slums and who lack proper food, housing and access to healthy sanitary system. The Diocese was built primarily by the American Holy Cross missionaries about 175 years ago. At present, there are 85,000 Catholics in 26 parishes and 24 sub-centers. There are about 35 Religious Congregations.

Bangladesh is an underdeveloped country in which 70% of people live in rural areas and depend on the agricultural product. The unpredictable weather becomes a significant problem with drought, heavy monsoon rain, natural calamities like cyclone, floods etc. Bangladesh is one of the poorest countries in the world; 60% of people are poor. The government health service is very inadequate and covers only 40% of people. Many people go to the village doctors, where they are cheated by traditional medicines. The treatment in private hospitals is very expensive. One physician is responsible for 10,000 patients. In the government health sector, there is high degree of corruption and mismanagement. There is no health insurance and many hospitals and doctors are very business-oriented.

We have a small hospital in Dhaka city with 20 beds meant for low income families and the poor. In the last two years, we ran the hospital in deficit. Now, we can manage the running expenses. We hope to extend more services to the poor and needy. Therefore, we need to create more facilities to do so. Secondly, out of four regions of Dhaka, in one region there is a possibility of evangelization especially among the indigenous people. We would like to spend money from the Mission Appeals for these two intentions.

Though this dogma of our faith had been held and believed by the faithful from the earliest times of our Church, especially since it was witnessed by those closest to our Blessed Mother at the time of her glorious Assumption, it wasn't until November 1, 1950, that Pope Pius XII solemnly proclaimed it to be so, raising this teaching of our faith to the level of a dogma, meaning, it must be held and believed by all. In part, the Holy Father declared, "we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

Reflect, this week, with the whole Church, upon the Most Glorious Ever-Virgin Mary who was conceived without sin, remained sinless throughout her life, and was taken body and soul into Heaven where she now adores the Most Holy Trinity and intercedes for you and for the whole Church. This is a Solemnity of great rejoicing! Share in this joy with the whole Church and with all the saints in Heaven!

Most glorious and Ever-Virgin Mary, I rejoice with you and with the whole Church for the most glorious things that God has done for you. You are beauty beyond beauty, Immaculate in every way, and worthy of our deepest love. As you now share body and soul in the glories of Heaven, please pray for me and for all your dear children on earth. Cover us with your mantle of love and pour forth the mercy of God upon us always.

Mother Mary, assumed into Heaven, pray for us who have recourse to thee.





Counseling By Fr. Rohrich


Counseling services are available with Fr. Bob Rohrich.
