

On a run-of-the-mill, 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time, you came out of nowhere and donated a **whop-ping** 1,089 lbs. of food and goods! That's only the third time since partnering with Elsie's Pantry have we broken the 1,000 lbs. threshold. Secondly, Elsie's Pantry continues serving around 266 people per week. A portion of those clients are senior citizens whom live alone. So, an emphasis on smaller, easy prep type meal donations are appreciated. Keep that in mind as we conduct our September **food collection next weekend (9/16 - 9/17)**.

Finally, it should go without saying. But, unfortunately, it has to be said. Please do not donate expired or opened products. For the past several months, there's been a steady increase in both expired and opened food items being donated. We filter out what we find. But bottom line, if it's not in a condition you would eat, please don't donate it.
