As you know, food prices everywhere have steadily increased. Our Fair Trade ministry is keeping our sales prices in line with our costs. For example, we buy decaf coffee from reputable farmers for \$9.70 per bag. So, this year, we must sell decaf for \$10 per bag.

As market prices fluctuate, our ministry will adapt.

Returning this season is an old favorite: olive oil. And something new: cookie and scone baking mixes.

Stop by the Narthex and chapel hallway to purchase coffee, tea, chocolate, and other delicious products. Your purchase is more than a donation. It helps families stay on their farms and ethically produce good products. Thank you for your continued support.

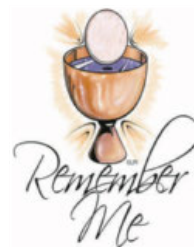

For the past several months, there's been a steady increase in both expired and opened food items being donated. We filter out what we find. 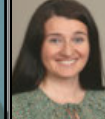

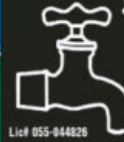

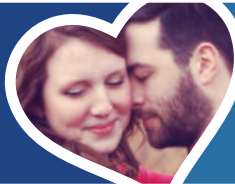
