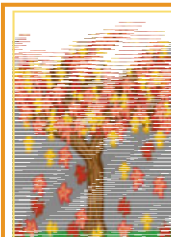
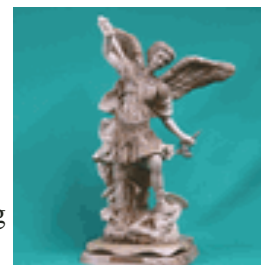

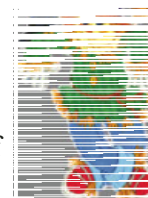
SACRED HEART WOMEN'S CCW

MEN'S HOLY NAME

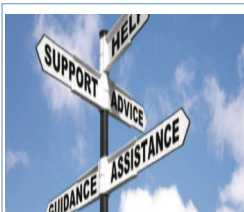
