


Creation Care Corner

Reduce the Impact of Acquisition

It's always a good time to reflect on our relationship with the environment: how we live and how our lifestyles impact the natural world. The sum total of all our daily purchases can have a huge effect on our environment. Consider scrutinizing purchases that utilize non-renewable resources, that have excessive global warming emissions, or generate more toxic waste from their manufacture. Also try to be mindful that the next day delivery services we may prefer often utilize 1/2-empty trucks scurrying across town, contributing to more air pollution. Consider examining what you really need, how quickly you need it, its environmental impact, and whether it even needs to be a "new" purchase. 


An Invitation to Pray
