Wintertime Tips to Save Energy, Money and Reduce Harmful Carbon Pollution

- 1) Use a programmable thermostat to reduce heat when you are away from home or asleep.
- 2) Seal and weatherstrip: you could improve the heating system efficiency by as much as 20%.
- 3) Keep your furnace air filters clean. At minimum, change the filter every three months.
- 4) Have HVAC equipment tuned-up annually.
- 5) **Turn off kitchen, bath, and other exhaust fans** within 20 minutes after use.
- 6) Close your fireplace damper when not in use.
- 7) Draperies and shades: Keep south-facing window shades open during the day and closed at night.

8) Select energy-efficient products when you buy new heating equipment. Look for Energy Star certification.

9) Make sure vents/registers aren't blocked or covered. More energy saving tips at:

Tickets will be sold at the Fun Club meeting on Wednesday, November 15th and Wednesday, December 6th.


