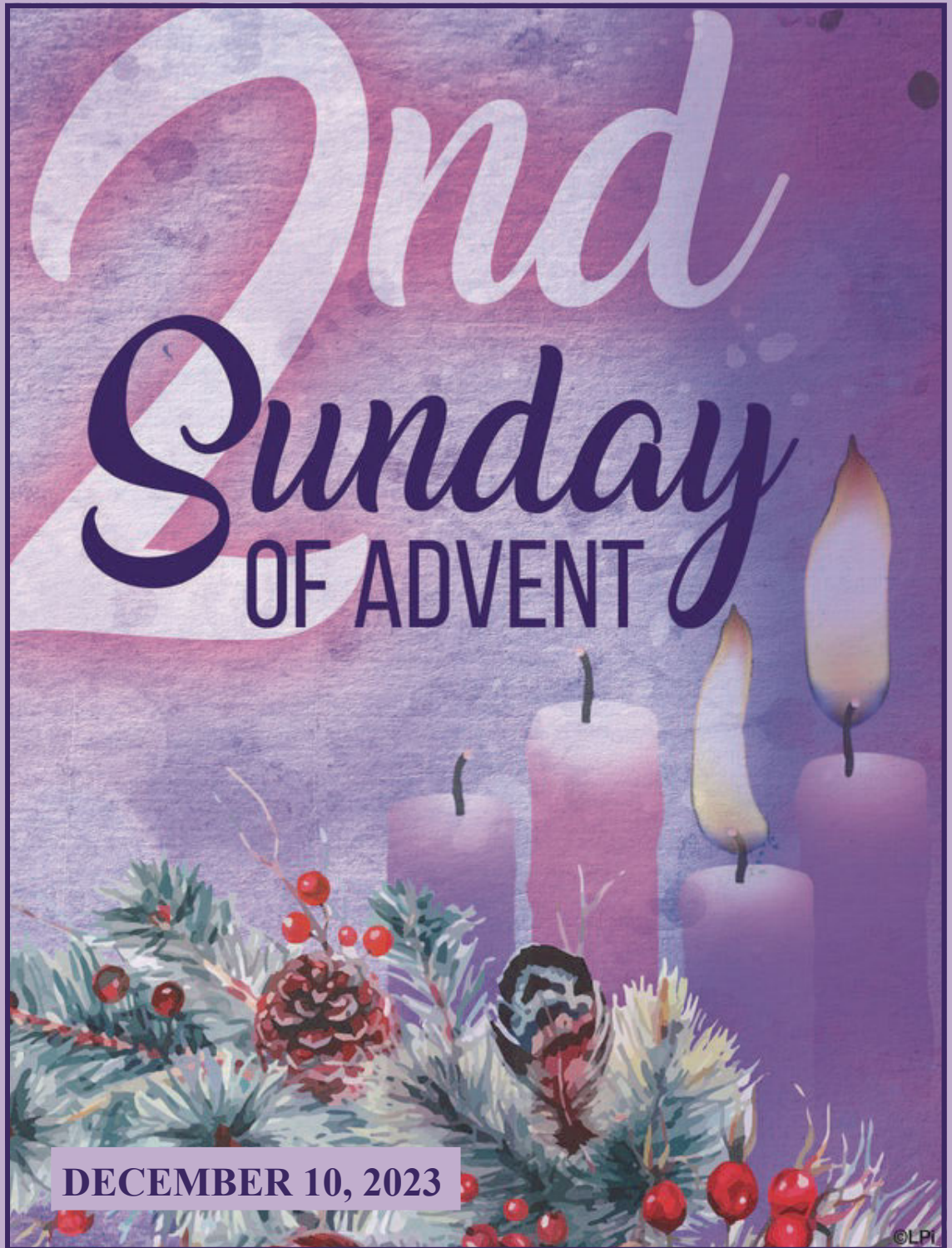

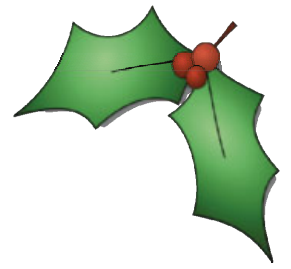

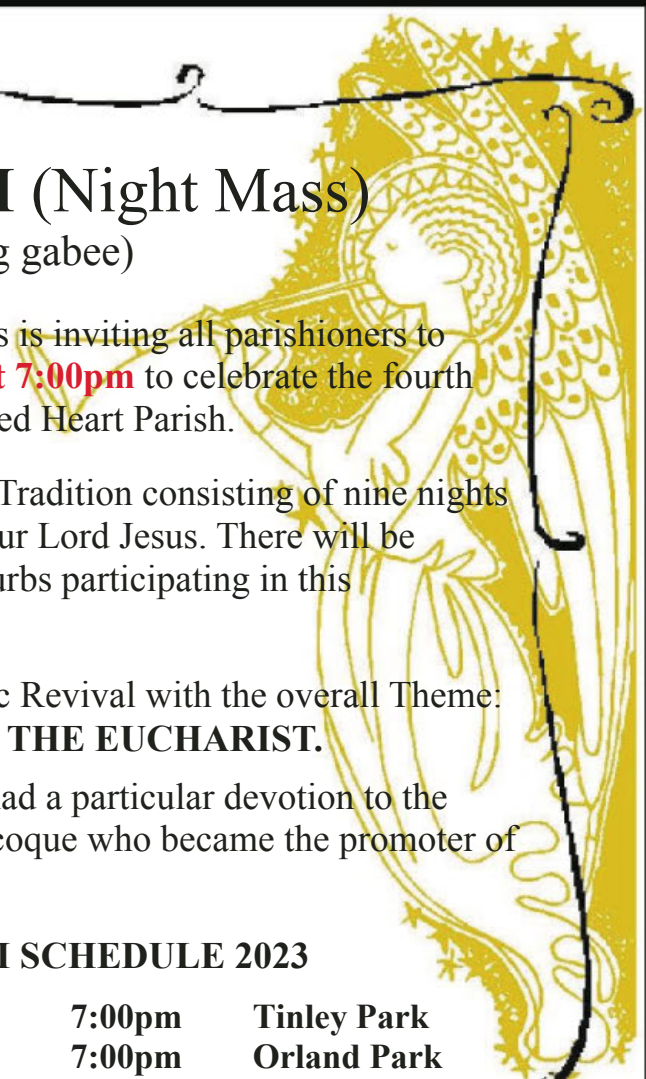
This year's Novena will focus on Eucharistic Revival with the overall Theme:

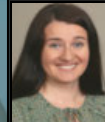

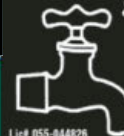

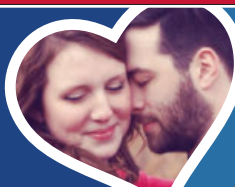
