“And the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us” (J 1,14)

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Christmas is a time of peace and love, for which we long. Still, we are tormented by constant conflicts affecting our families, workplaces, politics and social life, but also those that affect entire nations. Many speak about peace, or attempt to “fight” for peace, and there is no peace. They forget that peace is a gift from God and one must first desire to receive it from God.

Jesus born in a manger in Bethlehem is the Word of God dwelling among us, who says to each one of us *“Peace be with you.”* The words of the prophet Isaiah are fulfilled in Jesus. – *the Prince of Peace* (Is 9, 5).

God Himself came down from Heaven to dwell among us – to bring us peace, love and to cast away all fear! The peace that Jesus gives us is real. It is not the peace of this world, or peace with the world, but rather peace in the midst of this world. Jesus says, *“Peace I leave you, My peace I give you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid!”* (J 14,27)

Jesus renews our relationship with the Father, lost through sin, restores the original harmony, and so brings us back into the heart of God, in which we can experience constant peace and joy.

May the celebration of the birth of our Savior, fill our hearts with the heavenly gift of peace and love so that the words of St. Paul may be fulfilled in us *“And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts to which indeed you were called in the one body”* (Col 3, 15).

„Słowo stało się ciałem i zamieszkało między nami” (J 1,14)

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele naszej parafii,

Boże Narodzenie to czas pokoju i miłości, za którymi tęsknimy. Umęczeni jesteśmy ciągłymi wojnami i niepokojami, tymi codziennymi, toczącymi się w naszych rodzinach, miejscach pracy, w polityce i życiu społecznym, ale także tymi wojnami, które dotyczą całych narodów, rozgrywają się na świecie. Wszyscy mówią o pokoju, „walczą” o pokój, a pokoju nie ma, bo pokój jest darem Boga i należy najpierw pragnąć go od Boga przyjąć.

Dzieciątko Jezus przychodzące na świat w betlejemskiej stajence jest Słowem Boga, które mówi człowiekowi, każdemu z nas: „*Pokój z Tobą*”. W Jezusie spełniają się proroctwa Izajasza: rodzi się Księżę Pokoju (Iz, 9, 5), Władca, który rządzi pokojem. Patrzymy na dzieciątka Jezus i Ono napęłnia nas pokojem, prowokuje do miłości, oddala wszelki lęk, ponieważ sam Bóg zstąpił z nieba, aby być Bogiem z nami.

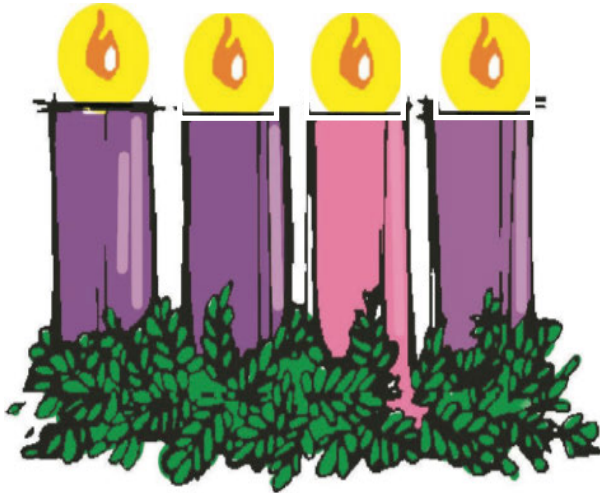
Pokój, którego udziela nam Jezus jest prawdziwy, nie jest to jednak pokój tego świata, czy też pokój ze światem, ale raczej pokój pośród tego świata. „Pokój zostawiam wam, pokój mój daję wam. Nie tak jak daje świat, Ja wam daję. Niech się nie trwoży serce wasze ani się lęka!” – mówi Jezus (J 14, 27). On odnawia naszą utraconą przez grzech więź z Bogiem, przywraca pierwotną harmonię i przez to na nowo wprowadza nas w życie Boże, w życie wieczne, którego znakiem jest pokój i radość, ponieważ ta bliska relacja z Bogiem przewyższa wszystko.

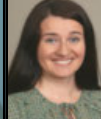

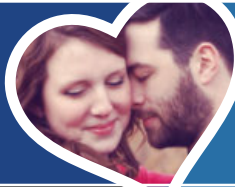
