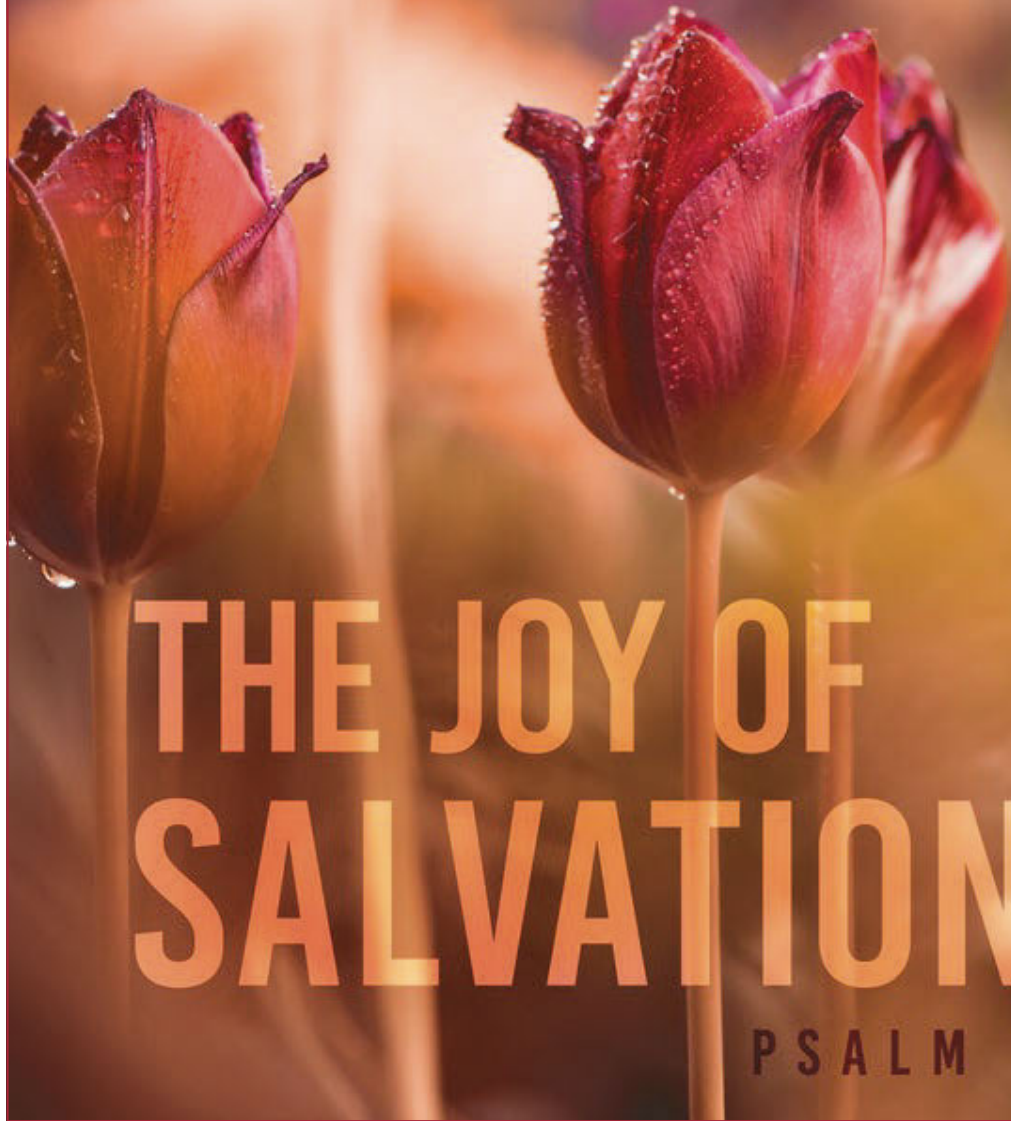

ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL COMMITMENT SUNDAY HOMILY 6TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, 11 FEBRUARY 2024 CARDINAL BLASE CUPICH

In today's Gospel, Jesus cures a leper. As he does so we gain an insight into his mission, a mission he gives to us. Leprosy is a terrible physical affliction. It is painful and it disfigures the body. But unlike other illnesses, it is a disease that isolates the leper for he must live away and apart from the community. We know from our recent experience of the pandemic how loneliness and isolation can bring great suffering.

Notice that Jesus heals not only the skin disease, but the whole man, body, soul, and spirit so that the leper can rejoin the family and the community, including worshipping community, as he is told to show himself to the priest. Jesus heals in a way that restores the leper's humanity, for the leper is once again someone who belongs to others, as he talks, worships, works, and eats with all in the community. Belonging is what it means to be fully human.

Jesus asks us to do the same on his behalf, to heal in a way that restores the humanity of others by making room at the table of life for all. Each year we take up this mission with fresh energy through the Annual Catholic Appeal. This is Commitment Weekend for the Appeal and in light of the Gospel we have chosen the theme *Together at the table*. We take up this mission together but also to make sure that everyone is included. We are true to Christ's mission when we reach out to those in need with his healing power, restoring their humanity and doing all we can to let them know that they belong.

Through the Appeal, we as one body reach out to struggling parish communities, schools, religious education and ministry formation programs, and respect life and peace initiatives in the Archdiocese. Through Catholic Relief Services, we also reach out to people beyond our local Church who are suffering from illnesses, natural disasters, and the calamities of war.

Together at the table – that is our vision, our mission, and our purpose. As your financial circumstances permit, please join me and other Catholics and make a gift to the Annual Appeal. Once your parish meets its goal, proceeds will return to your parish to support its mission in your local community. Belonging means coming together at the table of life in all its forms, but especially at the Eucharistic table, the altar of the Lord's sacrifice. It is at this table that we are renewed and become fully human, for it is here that we experience what it means to belong to each other and to belong to Christ. As you celebrate the Eucharist today and find healing in experiencing what it means to be fully human, as someone who belongs to others and to Christ, I pray that you will join with me in taking up the healing mission of Jesus so that all will find a place at the table of life.

Please take some time to pray and reflect on what it means for you to carry on the healing and gathering mission of Jesus, so that we can all be *Together at the table* and how that might inspire you to support the Annual Catholic Appeal.

NIEDZIELA ZOBOWIĄZANIA DOROCZNEJ KWESTY KATOLICKIEJ 2024

6. NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA, CYKL B, 11 LUTEGO 2024

HOMILIA KSIĘDZA KARDYNAŁA BŁAŻEJA CUPICHA

W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Jezus uzdrawia trędowatego. Dokonując tego, daje nam wgląd w swoją misję, tę samą misję, którą On sam nam przekazał. Trąd jest straszną chorobą fizyczną. Jest bolesny i zniekształca ciało. W przeciwieństwie do innych chorób, ta izoluje chorego, ponieważ zmusza go do życia w odosobnieniu. Z niedawnego doświadczenia pandemii wiemy, jak wielkie cierpienia mogą wynikać z samotności i izolacji.

Zauważmy jednak, że Jezus uzdrawia nie tylko chorobę skóry, ale całego człowieka, jego ciało, duszę i psychikę. Czyni tak, aby trędowaty mógł ponownie dołączyć do rodziny i swojej społeczności, w tym również do wspólnoty, w której oddaje chwałę Bogu, powiedziano mu przecież, aby poszedł i pokazał się kapłanowi. Jezus uzdrawia trędowatego w sposób, który przywraca choremu poczucie ludzkiej godności, trędowaty odzyskuje poczucie przynależności do wspólnoty, odtąd znów uczestniczy w rozmowach z innymi, modli się z nimi, pracuje i bierze udział we wspólnych posiłkach. Poczucie przynależności do społeczeństwa oznacza bycie w pełni człowiekiem.

Jezus prosi, abyśmy w Jego imieniu robili to samo, co On czyni innym, abyśmy uzdrawiali w sposób, który przywraca innym poczucie ludzkiej godności, robiąc dla nich miejsce przy stole życia. Każdego roku z nową energią podejmujemy tę misję poprzez Doroczną Kwestę Katolicką. Aktualnie przeżywamy Weekend Zobowiązania na rzecz Kwesty, na którą, zainspirowani Ewangelią, w bieżącym roku wybraliśmy hasło Przy wspólnym stole. Podjęliśmy tę misję razem, aby mieć pewność, że każdy będzie w nią włączony. Jesteśmy wierni misji Chrystusa, gdy docieramy do potrzebujących z Jego uzdrawiającą mocą, przywracamy im poczucie ludzkiej godności i robimy wszystko, co w naszej mocy, aby dać im również poczucie przynależności.

Poprzez Kwestę, jako jedno ciało, docieramy do wspólnot parafialnych borykających się z trudnościami, docieramy do szkół, programów edukacji religijnej, formacji duszpasterskiej oraz inicjatyw na rzecz poszanowania życia i pokoju w naszej Archidiecezji. Poprzez Katolicką Organizację Pomocy Humanitarnej docieramy również do ludzi spoza naszego lokalnego Kościoła, którzy cierpią z powodu chorób, klęsk żywiołowych i nieszczęść wojennych.

Przy wspólnym stole - oto nasza wizja, misja i nasz cel. Proszę, abyście w miarę swoich możliwości finansowych przyłączyli się do mnie i innych katolików w złożeniu daru na rzecz Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej. Kiedy parafia osiągnie swoją docelową kwotę, dodatkowo zebrane fundusze zostaną zwrócone parafii na wsparcie jej misji w lokalnej wspólnoty.

Dawanie innym poczucia przynależności oznacza spotkanie się przy stole życia we wszystkich jego formach, ale szczególnie przy stole eucharystycznym, ołtarzu ofiary Pana. To przy tym stole jesteśmy odnawiani i stajemy się w pełni ludźmi, ponieważ to tutaj doświadczamy, co to znaczy należeć do siebie nawzajem i należeć do Chrystusa. Modlę się dziś, kiedy celebруем Eucharystię i doświadczamy uzdrowienia przez pełnię człowieczeństwa jako ci, którzy należą do siebie nawzajem i do Chrystusa, abyście przyłączyli się do mnie w podejmowaniu uzdrawiającej misji Jezusa, aby wszyscy znaleźli miejsce przy stole życia.

Proszę, poświęć trochę czasu na modlitwę i refleksję nad tym, co oznacza dla ciebie kontynuowanie uzdrawiającej i jednoczącej misji Jezusa, abyśmy wszyscy mogli być przy Przy wspólnym stole. Pomyśl jak może to zainspirować cię do wsparcia Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej.

Niech dobry Bóg błogosławi i zachowa Was i wszystkich Waszych bliskich w swojej opatrznościowej opiece. Bóg zapłać!

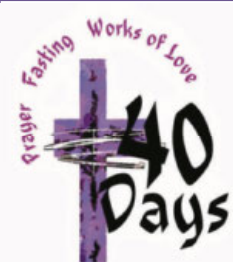

Getting Ready for Lent

The Church knows from centuries of experience that we really don't start getting into Lent until we receive ashes on our forehead on Ash Wednesday.

The next three days—the Thursday, Friday and Saturday after Ash Wednesday—are a time for us to start “warming up” for Lent. These days are something like “pre-season games” in most sports. We start our Lenten practices, but we're getting the feel of it, and making our plans. Then, with the first full week of Lent we're into it with full force. The 40 days of Lent are measured from the First Sunday of Lent until Holy Thursday, then we begin the “Triduum” — the three

holiest days of the year: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Stations of the Cross will start on Friday, February 16th and will continue every Friday during Lent.

What is a Sabbatical?

In his book *Sabbath Time*, spiritual writer Tilden Edwards speaks about the rhythm of life for many people that alternates between work and escape. Although both work and escape, he suggests, are good and valid, a life solely defined by work-and-escape can be sorely diminished. The biblical experience of sabbath time introduce another, soul-enriching dimension. Sabbath time is neither work nor escape but an alert and attentive resting in God.

That understanding of sabbath is at the heart of the sabbaticals offered to priests of the Archdiocese of Chicago. These sabbaticals offer priests an opportunity to rest in God, re-energize their relationship with Jesus as his disciples, and to grow in ministerial skills and availability.

Priests' sabbaticals in the Archdiocese of Chicago also draw on the four formational pillars identified in Pope Saint John Paul II's apostolic exhortation *Pastores dabo vobis*: human, intellectual, spiritual, and pastoral. In that light, each sabbatical contains these essential elements: (1) an experience of theological or pastoral education or research; (2) a retreat at a Catholic retreat center or pilgrimage (The way of St. James); (3) a period of rest and vacation and renewing connections with friends and family.

The Archdiocesan Sabbatical Board helps eligible Chicago priests design, plan, and then submit a sabbatical proposal for the Archbishop's approval.



Czym jest Urlop Sabatyczny?

W swojej książce pt.: „Sabbath Time” pisarz Tilden Edwards mówi o rytmie życia wielu ludzi, który biegnie pomiędzy pracą a ucieczką. Autor stwierdza, że zarówno praca, jak i ucieczka są dobre i ważne, to tak naprawdę życie definiowane wyłącznie przez pracę i ucieczkę może zostać poważnie nadszarpnięte i prowadzić do wewnętrznych szkód. Biblijne doświadczenie czasu szabatu wprowadza inny, wzbogacający duszę wymiar. Okres tak pojętego czasu sabatycznego nie jest ani pracą, ani ucieczką, ale czujnym i uważnym odpoczynkiem w Bogu.

Takie właśnie rozumienie leży u podstaw urlopów sabatycznych oferowanych księżom Archidiecezji Chicago. Czas urlopu sabatycznego daje kapłanom możliwość odpoczynku w Bogu, ożywienia swojej relacji z Jezusem jako Jego uczniami oraz wzrostu umiejętności posługiwania i dyspozycyjności.

Urlopy księży w archidiecezji Chicago opierają się również na czterech filarach formacyjnych wskazanych w adhortacji apostolskiej papieża św. Jana Pawła II pt. „Pastores dabo vobis”: ludzkim, intelektualnym, duchowym i duszpasterskim. W tym świetle każdy urlop sabatyczny zawiera następujące istotne elementy: (1) pogłębienie wiedzy teologicznej lub badania naukowe lub duszpasterskie; (2) rekolekcje w katolickim ośrodku rekolekcyjnym lub pielgrzymka (Droga do grobu św. Jakuba, Camino); (3) okres odpoczynku i wakacji oraz odnowienia kontaktów z przyjaciółmi i rodziną.

Archidiecezjalna Rada pomaga uprawnionym księżom z Chicago w projektowaniu, planowaniu, a następnie przedkładaniu propozycji urlopu sabatowego do zatwierdzenia przez Arcybiskupa.

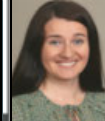

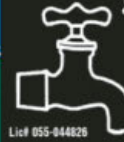

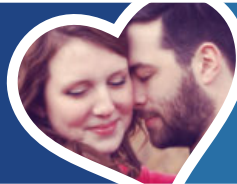
