PLEASE NOTE: Names received after Tuesday, May 7 will be placed on the altar and remembered at the Mother's Day Masses. However, if by time constraints they are unable to be included in the Mother's Day bulletin, the names will appear in the May 18-19 bulletin.





Calculate your carbon footprint.

Popes Francis, Benedict XVI and John Paul II have all spoken of the need to address climate change. It's influenced by the amount of heat trapping CO2 and other greenhouse gases (GHGs) in the atmosphere. Small atmospheric GHG % increases can have a significant impact on Earth's temperature rise. Every day, across everything we do and buy, we contribute to GHG emissions. Calculators can help us better understand how much carbon is produced by different activities. Then, if you decide to reduce your emissions, you'll know where you can generate the biggest impact. Start with this easy to use calculator: https://www3.epa.gov/carbon-footprint-calculator/ (This EPA calculator does not include air travel, which often is a major contributor to household emissions, but can still help you ID great savings opportunities).




An Invitation to Pray

Father Bob counsels engaged & married couples, individuals for depression, anxiety, grieving, separation, divorce, and other personal problems. Cost for each session is \$10.



Reconciliation: Saturday, 3:15 -4:00 PM or appointment. Instruction in Catholic Faith call Ministry Office.

Marriages: Friday 4:00PM, Saturday 12:00 PM and 2:00 PM. Pre-Marriage instructions required. Arrangements should be made, according to Archdiocesan policy, at least six months before the wedding. Dates and times not set at initial phone call, but must be confirmed by the officiating priest or deacon.
