## Creation Care Corner



**INTEGRAL ECOLOGY** is a concept Pope Francis explores in his encyclical Laudato Si'. It's a perspective needed if we want to make significant progress on creation care concerns because "...everything in the world is connected" (LS 16). "Nature...," Francis writes, "cannot be regarded as something separate from ourselves or as a mere setting in which we live." "We are part of nature." So, in considering solutions to the environmental crisis, we need to "seek comprehensive solutions which consider the interactions within natural systems themselves and with social systems." This, Francis says, is because "we are not faced with two separate crises, one environmental and the other social, but rather one complex crisis which is both social and environmental."

By adopting a perspective based on an integral ecology, new insights can be generated for a more holistic approach to problem solving that promotes care for each other, as well as the earth. Francis states, "...that genuine care for our own lives and our relationships with nature is inseparable from fraternity, justice and faithfulness to others" (LS 70). And in recognizing our interconnectedness within the ecosystems that sustain us, we will stop seeing God's creation as simply existing to serve our needs. We'll better understand our place within the delicate web of life. For more information:


