National Eucharistic Revival

In June 2022, on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the U.S. Council of Catholic Bishops launched a three-year National Eucharistic Revival to respond to Christ's call for us to unite around the source and summit of our faith: the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

The National Eucharistic Revival movement is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the Church in the United States to the divine invitation to be united once again around the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist.

The vision of the National Eucharistic Revival is to inspire a movement of Catholics across the United States who are healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and who are then sent out on mission "for the life of the world." Through the Eucharist, God desires to heal, renew, and unify the Church and the world.

This weekend marks the conclusion of Year Two of the National Eucharistic Revival. Throughout the Archdiocese, parishes, including here at Sacred Heart, are hosting special events, Masses and Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction.

REVIVAL IS NOT SOMETHING WE DO. IT'S GOD STIRRING UP THE HEARTS OF HIS PEOPLE. In keeping with the vision of the National Eucharistic Revival, the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is accompanying Jesus from city to city, lighting hearts on fire along the way.



While everyone is invited to walk with the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage for short distances or join one of the many events along the way, only a few young adults will make the full journey to the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. We call these young adults "Perpetual Pilgrims."

Departing from the headwaters of the Mississippi, the Marian Route descends through the Midwest and passes through Wisconsin and Illinois. On July 16, 2024, all four U.S. pilgrimage routes will converge for the 10th National Eucharistic Congress—a milestone within the Revival and a historic moment for the Church in the United States.

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is coming through the Archdiocese of Chicago June 26 - 30. This is a unique moment in our history to reaffirm Jesus Christ as the center of our lives, rediscover the power and beauty of the Mass as the Source and Summit of Christian Life, and reinvigorate our sense of mission to share God's love.



Every year, the Archdiocese of Chicago invites missionary groups to speak at its parishes through the nationwide Mission Cooperation Plan. Missionary groups share their stories and solicit prayers and financial support for their service through second collections. This year, on the weekend of July 13th and 14th, our parish will welcome Mr. Damian Kabot from the Lay Mission-Helpers Association (LMH) - an organization that makes it possible for lay Catholic professionals to share their talents and witness their Catholic faith in mission dioceses around the world. Since its foundation in Los Angeles in 1955, LMH has sent over 750 lay men, women, and families on mission to 37 countries. Currently, LMH serves in Ghana, Uganda and Peru. Their missionaries come from across the United States and serve three-year terms as teachers, nurses, computer technicians, project managers, accountants, administrators, pastoral workers and other professionals. WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION:

Plastic waste is a huge and growing problem. Only 9% of the 9 billion tons of plastic produced has been recycled. There is very little demand for the plastic you do recycle. 40% of all plastic is designed to be used once and tossed. Plastic doesn't decompose easily and can last 100s of years. The waste clogs landfills and waterways, and poses hazards to animals and fish life. It breaks up into ever smaller microplastics getting into our air and food chain with unknown health effects.

What you can do:

• Say NO to single-use plastic. Carry your own cups, bags, to-go containers, utensils and forget the straws.

- Say NO to bottled water and pop. Carry refillables.
- Choose more biodegradable/recyclable materials like glass, paper, cardboard and metal instead of plastic... and then recycle those items.
- Avoid products with excessive packaging, excessive plastic packaging and parts. If it leaves behind plastic trash, try not to buy it.

Recycle what you can't refuse, reduce or reuse.
