Dear Parishioners,

As many of you know, we have been in process of replacing the rooftop AC units in the church. Joe Fuks, the president of First Star HVAC Inc., is the installer of the units.

This is a **2 PHASE** project with the following scope of work:

Dismantle existing 4 rooftop units, removal, fabrication necessary sheet metal ducts to reinstall new equipment into existing duck work, reconnecting existing gas and electric into the new equipment. Extra charges for sheet metal work for 2 units with 1 inch duct liner and new 14 inch curbs were included in the total.

PHASE 1 is completed – 2 units have been replaced.

RTU -1 20 Ton, 208/230V

RTU-4 30 Ton, 208/230V

(RTU-4 the 30 Ton unit was ordered back in July 2023. We didn't get it until March of 2024)

TOTAL COST OF PHASE 1 - \$189,000.00

PHASE 2 – 2 units are ordered and awaiting delivery and installation.

RTU -2 15 Ton, 208/230V

RTU-4 27.5 Ton, 208/230V

TOTAL COST OF PHASE 2 - \$185,460.00

<u>The replacement of the AC rooftop units was paid for with the proceeds from To Teach</u> <u>Who Christ Is, the parish savings and the Capital Improvement fund.</u>

WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION: Reduce outdoor watering waste.

Experts estimate that 50 percent of the water we use outdoors goes to waste from evaporation, wind, or runoff due to overwatering. Frequent lawn watering is expensive and often unnecessary. A typical lawn only needs about one inch of water per week to survive. So if there is no rain, water every 6-8 days to reduce your water bill. A best practice: water for 15 minutes then allow the water to soak in for a while and repeat 3-4 times, lessening waste of water by runoff. This deeper soaking technique encourages the roots to grow deeper and be more drought resistant. Water early in the morning or at sunset to reduce loss from evaporation. Check the spigots for leaks.

Music Department News

Hello! Sue and I have been the Directors of Music Ministry since 2018. We love being part of this family! During our time here, we have improved the sound system, worked to build the choir, added a new vocal group (Voices of Praise) and brought new music to you. With the help of Sacred Heart organizations and your generous donations, we were fortunate to be able to update our Gather books in 2020.



Currently we are looking to upgrade the piano in the church. Let me explain.

First of all, given the age of the electronic piano, there have been a number of service calls that have been made and parts have been replaced. However, the parts needed to keep it up and running are hard to get because of the age of the instrument. Just like many other older instruments or appliances, as they age, companies don't carry parts for very long because new models come out every year.

There are issues with the current piano that are concerning and indicate a failure could happen soon and a quick decision would need to be made to replace it and could leave us without a piano. Therefore, we need to be proactive in replacing the piano before it breaks down. In the world of technology things change very fast and what's new this year is obsolete and out of date a year or two later. We all know this when it comes to our cell phones, computers and TVs. This brings out the second point.

The proposal here is not to go electronic but acoustic. Acoustic pianos have been around for hundreds of years and all pianists prefer and perform better on the acoustic piano as it is the real instrument. Electronic pianos are lower quality and an imitation of the acoustic piano. An acoustic piano from a reputable manufacturer of high-quality pianos can last over 50 years. In comparison, electronic pianos are lower quality and are rated 10-20 years.




