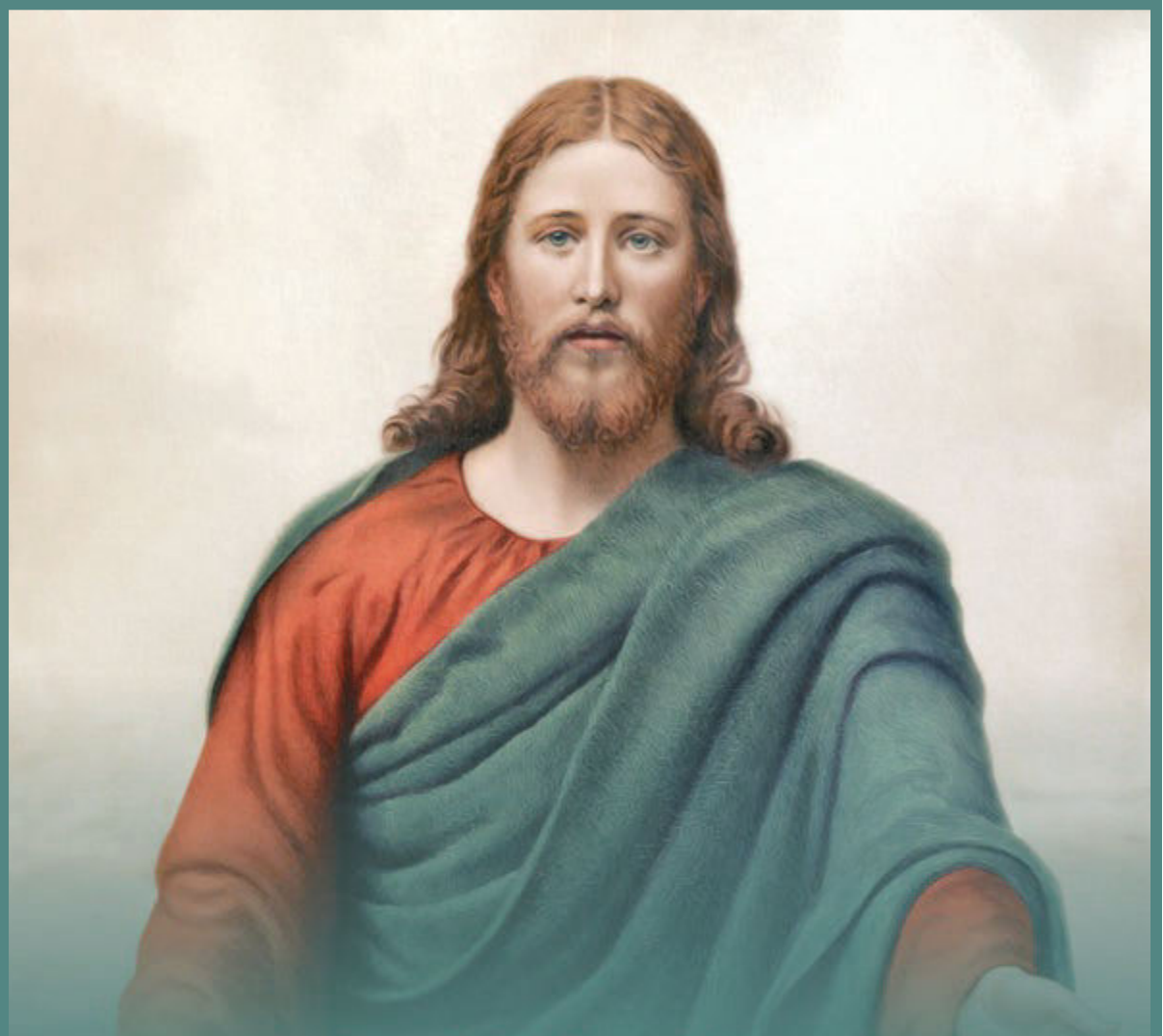

“Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.” - Mk 8:34b

Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass ©2001, 1998, 1970 CCD.

SEPTEMBER 15, 2024

My dear Parishioners, Sisters and Brothers,

Jesus asks His disciples, “Who do people say I am?” And immediately after their answers He asks, “And who do YOU say I am?” In other words: Who am I to you? What do YOU think of me? On the one hand, one might think that the Lord Jesus tests His Apostles. On the other hand, having His own plan, He expects the right answer. Of course, we are also asked by the Lord, “Who am I to you? Who do you say I am?” And what will my answer be? Let’s think...

In the last paragraph, a Christian paradox appears once again. So interestingly formulated by Jesus: “Do you want to follow me, do you want to be my disciple? Deny yourself, take up your cross and follow me...” And now we have a “problem”, because in the next sentence Jesus adds: “whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it”. And so here we go: whoever wants to keep their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and the Gospel will live...

Nothing is impossible for God, nothing is lost for Him. Even if our life were one long series of torment and failures – we always have a chance in God’s eyes. Let’s look at the Good Thief on the cross. We always have a chance to return to God, always, at every moment of our life. We can “lose” our life in human terms, but in God’s eyes it will have a beautiful, immortal value.

But who is Jesus Christ to me?

A week ago, during the Mass at 4:30 on Saturday, I mentioned my visits to my parents in Poland. I would like to share it with you in this way as well. My parents are in beautiful age: my mom is 85, and my dad is 92. Each of you who takes care of or has taken care of your loved ones at such a beautiful age knows that there is always something you can help your loved ones with. When I come back from my parents’ house, you often ask me: “How was your vacation?” ☺ And I put on a good face and I try to say something. Why? Because as many of you can guess, it’s not really a vacation. At home, there’s always a plan, schedule ready for me: doctor’s visits with my parents, shopping, cleaning, sorting out various things, trips to see our family, and many other things to do, and once there was even painting the rooms. But please don’t ask me to paint your houses. ☺ Don’t even try to “hire” me. ☺ Ok. But don’t get me wrong, please! I’m absolutely not complaining! I love my parents so much and I pray for them and with them too. But these are the realities of my stays (“vacations”) at home, in Poland.

I offer my heartfelt thanks to you for all that you do for Sacred Heart Parish, for your sacrifice and support. I remember you in my everyday prayers, and I ask you to pray for me too, please. May God reward you with His blessing and graces!

Moi Drodzy Parafianie, Siostry i Bracia,

Jezus pyta swoich uczniów „Za kogo ludzie mnie uważają”? I zaraz po ich odpowiedziach pyta: „A **WY** za kogo mnie uważacie?” Innymi słowy: Kim dla Was jestem? Co **WY** o mnie myślicie? Z jednej strony można pomyśleć, że Pan Jezus „wypuszcza” swoich Apostołów, jakby ich testuje. A z drugiej strony mając swój plan spodziewa się właściwej odpowiedzi.

Oczywiście i my także jesteśmy pytani przez Pana Jezusa: „Kim jestem dla Ciebie? Za kogo mnie uważasz?” I jaka będzie moja odpowiedź? Pomyślmy...

W ostatnim akapicie dzisiejszej Ewangelii pojawia się po raz kolejny chrześcijański paradoks. Tak ciekawie sformułowany przez Pana Jezusa: „Chcesz pójść za mną, chcesz być moim uczniem? Zaprzyj się samego siebie, weź swój krzyż i chodź za mną...” No i teraz mamy „problem”, ponieważ w następnym zdaniu Jezus dodaje: „kto chce zachować swoje życie, straci je; a kto straci swe życie z powodu Mnie i Ewangelii, zachowa je”. No i mamy: kto chce zachować życie to je straci, ale kto straci życie dla mnie i Ewangelii ten będzie żył...

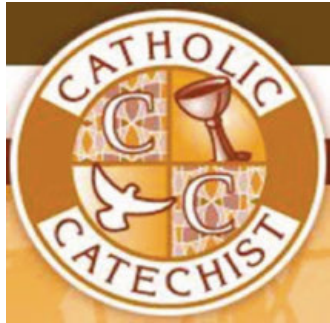
Dla Boga nie ma nic niemożliwego, dla Niego nie ma nic straconego. Nawet gdyby nasze życie było jednym pasmem udręki i niepowodzeń – zawsze – w Bożych oczach mamy szansę. Popatrzmy na Dobrego Łotra na krzyżu. Zawsze mamy szansę powrotu do Boga. Możemy po ludzku „stracić” życie, ale w oczach Boga będzie ono miało piękną, nieśmiertelną wartość.

Ale Kim jest dla mnie Jezus Chrystus?

Tydzień temu podczas Mszy Św. o 4:30 wspomniałem o moich wizytach w Polsce u moich rodziców. Chciałbym się tym z Wami podzielić także w ten sposób. Moi rodzice mają sporo lat: mama 85, a tato 92. Każdy z Was kto się opiekuje czy też opiekował swoimi bliskimi w tak pięknym wieku to wiecie, że zawsze jest coś w czym można swoim bliskim pomóc. Kiedy wracam od rodziców to często pytacie mnie: „Jak tam po wakacjach?” J A ja robię dobrą minę i coś odpowiadam. Bo jak się wielu z Was domyśla to nie za bardzo są wakacje. W domu zawsze czeka już na mnie plan mojego pobytu: wizyty u lekarza z rodzicami, zakupy, sprzątanie, porządkowanie różnych rzeczy, wyjazdy do rodziny, i wiele innych spraw do załatwienia, a nawet było i malowanie pokoi. Ale proszę mnie nie prosić o malowanie Waszych domów. J Ok. Proszę mnie nie zrozumcie mnie źle! Absolutnie nie narzekam! Bardzo kocham moich rodziców i modłę się za nich i z nimi także. Ale takie są po prostu realia moich pobytów w domu, w Polsce.

Składam Wam serdeczne podziękowania za wszystko, co robicie dla parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa, za Wasze poświęcenie i wsparcie. Pamiętam o Was i Waszych rodzinach w moich codziennych modlitwach i proszę Was, módlcie się za mnie. Niech Bóg Wam wynagrodzi swoim błogosławieństwem i łaskami!

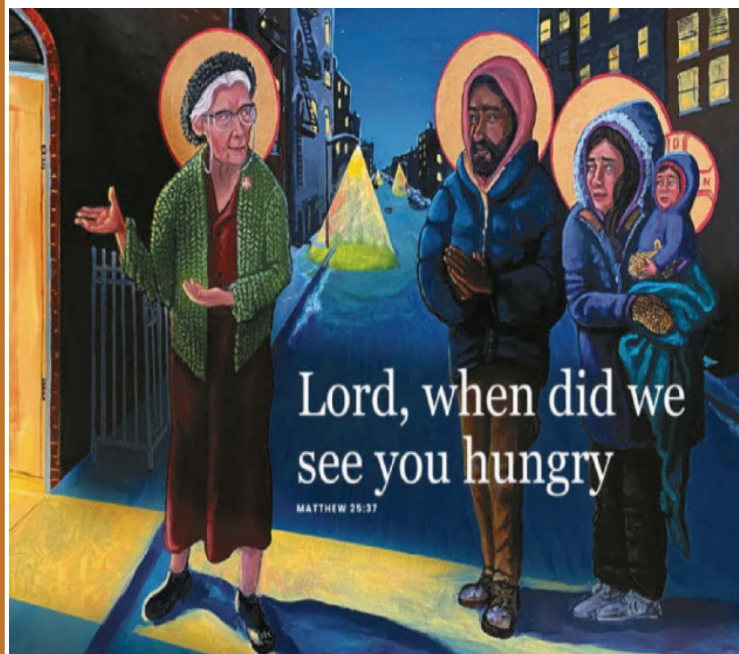
Catechetical Sunday

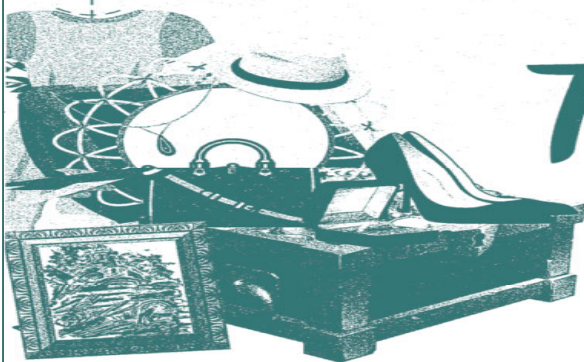

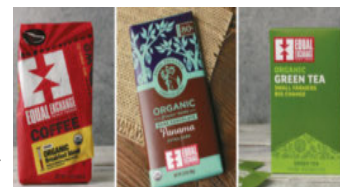

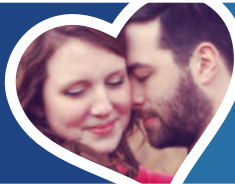
