At that time, John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us." Jesus replied, "Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me." - Mk 9:38-39

My dear Parishioners, Friends of our Parish, Brothers and Sisters,

Queen of the Rosary, pray for us! On Tuesday we'll begin a new month. And October in a special way is dedicated to Our Blessed Mother, Queen of the Rosary. Rosary prayer may seem uninteresting and even boring. Is it really? I don't think that one mom is bored when her children repeat: "I love you mom." The mother reacts to every child's call. The same thing is with the Rosary. Mary is our Mother. When we recite the rosary, we are like a baby, like a little kid. Is Mary happy with our words of love? I'm sure She is! This is an echo of the joyful meeting in Nazareth, where Angel Gabriel told her that she was "full of grace,"



and She accepted God's call with humility, calling herself the Lord's hand-maiden. If She is "full of grace," so we are aware of our imperfection. We ask her: "Pray for us sinners" so that we too may be filled with the grace of God's friendship.

Whenever Our Blessed Mary wanted to send the message to the world, she came to the chosen people with a rosary in Her hand and urged them to pray. It was in Lourdes in 1858, and so it was 107 years ago in Fatima in 1917. Rosary prayer is very important and especially pleasant for Mary, and very effective for human beings. It's coming out of the Gospel and it's a summary of it. Prisoners of concentration camps made rosaries from kneaded breads. And how many times in the pockets of fallen soldiers were found bloodstained rosaries? These items were sent as relics to family homes – to their wives, mothers and children. St. Padre Pio, two days before his death, said: "I would like to invite all sinners from all over the world to love the Mother

of God. Always pray the Rosary. And pray as often as you can. Satan is always trying to destroy this prayer, but he will never succeed. This is Her prayer who reigns over all. It was She who taught us to pray on the Rosary, so Jesus taught us to speak Our Father." Michelangelo, one of the world's greatest sculptors, created a monumental fresco that decorates the Sistine Chapel – *The Last Judgment*. In one scene, we see an angel handing a Rosary to one couple and the Rosary draws them to heaven.

The bishop, who was to decide whether to ordain the future Pastor of Ars, was afraid to make such a decision, because St. Jean-Marie Vianney was failing theology and Latin. Finally, the bishop asked him: "Do you know the rosary prayer?" "I love that prayer!" – answered Vianney. Satisfied with this answer, the bishop said, "Let's ordain him. He will be a good priest." One student taking a train in France took a seat next to a modestly dressed man who was praying the rosary. "Please take my advice and throw this rosary out the window and read a little what science is saying about your God. I will send you literature that will help you in this matter." But that man with silence gave the young man a business card: "Ludwik Pasteur, Director of the Institute for Research, Paris." Ludwik Pasteur was one of the greatest scientists in the 20th century and the creator of modern bacteriology. And every day he prayed a rosary!

I'd like to ask each of you to recite a decade of the Rosary, every single day during the month of October for the intentions of Sacred Heart Parish – for good will, peace and unity among us. I know you're working, you're busy – but I believe that we are a people of good will and our hearts hold the good of our parish. So, we will pray the Rosary together in this October for our parish. Okay?

May Mary, Queen of the Rosary be a constant sign of hope and peace for us! I wish you all a wonderful Sunday rest and a great week. I remember you in my everyday prayers, and I ask you to pray for me too, please. May God reward you all the good that you do for Sacred Heart Parish.

Moi Drodzy Parafianie, Siostry i Bracia,

We wtorek rozpoczniemy nowy miesiąc. Październik jest szczególnie poświęcony modlitwie różańcowej. Odmawianie różańca może się wydawać nieciekawe, a nawet nudne. Czy rzeczywiście? Nie sądzę, że którąś z matek nudzi nieustanne powtarzanie przez dzieci – "Kocham Cię mamo" Matka reaguje ona na każde odezwanie się dziecka. Podobnie jest z modlitwą różańcową. Maryja jest naszą Matką. Kiedy odmawiamy różaniec, jesteśmy podobni do małego dziecka. Powtarzamy jak ono: Bądź pozdrowiona, Matko! Czy Maryja cieszy się z tego pozdrowienia? Na pewno tak! Jest to przecież nawiązanie do radosnego wydarzenia w Nazarecie, gdzie Anioł Gabriel oznajmił Jej, że jest "łaski pełna", a Ona przyjęła to z pokorą,



nazywając siebie służebnicą Pańską. Jeżeli Ona jest "łaski pełna", to my świadomi własnej niedoskonałości, prosimy Ją: "Módl się za nami grzesznymi", abyśmy także napełnieni zostali łaską przyjaźni Bożej.

Ilekroć Maryja chciała przekazać światu swoje orędzie, zjawiała się wybranym ludziom z różańcem w ręku i usilnie zachęcała do jego odmawiania. Tak było w Lourdes w roku 1858, tak też było 107 lat temu w Fatimie w 1917. Z tego wynika, że modlitwa różańcowa jest dla Maryi szczególnie miła, a dla człowieka bardzo skuteczna. Wyrosła ona z Ewangelii i jest jej streszczeniem. Więźniowie obozów koncentracyjnych robili sobie różańce z ugniecionego chleba, którego paciorki włożone na nitkę przechowywali przed oprawcami i na nich się modlili. A ileż to razy w kieszeniach poległych żołnierzy znajdywano różańce, często zbroczone krwią? Przesyłano te przedmioty jako relikwie do rodzinnych domów – żonom i matkom. Św. ojciec Pio, na dwa dni przed swoją śmiercia powiedział:

"Chciałbym zaprosić wszystkich grzeszników z całego świata, aby kochali Matkę Bożą. Odmawiajcie zawsze różaniec. I odmawiajcie go tak często, jak tylko możecie. Szatan stara się zawsze zniszczyć tę modlitwę, ale mu to się nigdy nie uda. To jest modlitwa Tej, która króluje nad wszystkim i wszystkimi. To ona nauczyła nas modlić się na różańcu, tak ja Jezus nauczył nas mówić Ojcze nasz." W Kaplicy Sykstyńskiej na Watykanie ogromny fresk przedstawia "Sąd Ostateczny". Mnóstwo postaci: Chrystus, u jego boku Maryja, aniołowie. I jeden szczególny fragment: oto potężny Duch Boży dźwiga z otchłani w stronę nieba człowieka trzymającego się różańca!

Biskup, który miał zadecydować, czy wyświęcić na kapłana przyszłego proboszcza z Ars, bał się podjęcia takiej decyzji, ponieważ św. Jan Maria Vianney nie dawał sobie rady z nauką. W końcu biskup postawił decydujące pytanie: "Czy umiesz odmawiać różaniec?", "Kocham tę modlitwę!" odpowiedział Vianney. Słysząc taką odpowiedź biskup powiedział: "Wyświęćmy go. Będzie dobrym księdzem". Pewien student jadący pociągiem we Francji zajął miejsce obok skromnie ubranego mężczyzny, który odmawiał różaniec. "Proszę skorzystać z mojej rady i wyrzucić ten różaniec przez okno i trochę poczytać, co o Bogu mówi nauka. Prześlę panu literaturę, która panu w tej sprawie pomoże". Mężczyzna podał młodemu człowiekowi wizytówkę: "Ludwik Pasteur, Dyrektor Instytutu Badań Naukowych, Paryż". Ludwik Pasteur był jednym z największych naukowców w XX wieku i twórcą nowoczesnej bakteriologii. Każdego dnia odmawiał różaniec!

Odmawiajmy różaniec!

Chciałbym prosić każdego z Was, abyście odmawiali dziesiątkę różańca każdego dnia w październiku w intencji naszej parafii – o dobrą wolę, pokój i jedność między nami. Wiem, że pracujecie, że macie naprawdę bardzo mało czasu – ale wierzę, że jesteśmy ludźmi dobrej woli i nasze serca noszą w sobie dobro naszej parafii. Więc odmówimy wspólnie różaniec w październiku za naszą parafię. Dobrze?

Składam Wam serdeczne podziękowania za wszystko, co robicie dla parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa, za Wasze poświęcenie i wsparcie. Pamiętam o Was i Waszych rodzinach w moich codziennych modlitwach i proszę Was, módlcie się za mnie. Niech Bóg Wam wynagrodzi swoim błogosławieństwem i łaskami!
