Dear Parishioners,

My name is Renata Chlebek and I am the new Business Manager and the Director of Operation here at Sacred Heart Parish. I began in March of this year with the retirement of Emmett Williamson and I am grateful to be a part of this amazing parish. I look forward to serving here.

At this time I would also like to acknowledge and thank Tom Mooney, who is a member of the Finance Committee, for all his hard work and assistance with compiling this report. Please see the *To Teach Who Christ Is* Report below:

To Teach Who Christ Is Financial Report

This report covers a time period from September 29, 2015 up to the fiscal year end, June 30, 2024. Note that 98% of the donations were received by December 31, 2020.

A total of \$802,192 was donated from you, the generous parishioners of Sacred Heart. In this campaign, **40%, or \$320,877**, of the donations were kept by the Archdiocese of Chicago. This \$320,877 was used to provide scholarships, facility safety projects, religious education catechist training, enhancement of the academic excellence of Catholic schools, and innovative religious education programs.

This leaves \$481,315 for Sacred Heart, plus \$18,374 in interest which totals **\$499,689** to be spent at Sacred Heart. Your gifts were used for three different projects. The first project was a parking lot repair project in 2018 at a cost of \$51,700. The second project was a much bigger section of the parking lot that was repaired and paved in 2020 for \$277,527. The third project, at a cost of \$170,462, was replacing an air conditioner for the church in 2024. The three projects equal a total expense of **\$499,689**.

As a married couple and registered parishioners since 1972, John and Vernice live out the call to servant discipleship and leadership. Both John and Vernice are highly respected and involved members of our parish family and are true examples of the Gospel. A Prayer for Life to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament

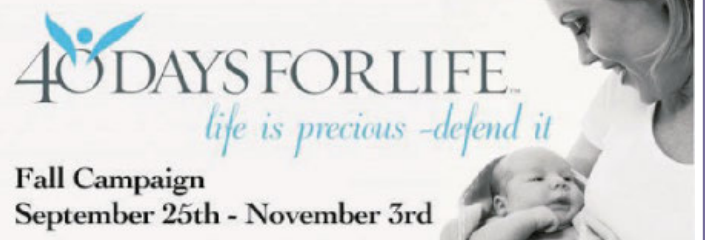

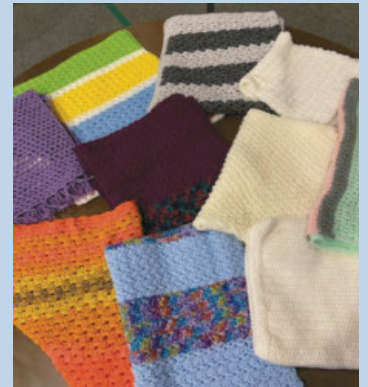

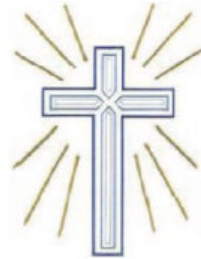

AVOIDING DOOMISM

For decades scientists and our popes have been trying to get the public's attention on climate change. Finally, more people are paying attention. Predictions of the negative impacts of climate change are daunting. And while fewer people are denying the existence of climate change, now there is a new problem: doomism. It's the feeling, especially among young people, that "nothing can be done about it, so why bother acting?"

Hopelessness leads to growing anxiety and despair that can result in inaction. Faith, hope, action and prayer are antidotes to doomism. Effectively reducing the impacts of climate change requires action: individual action, corporate action, action by our government, and action by governments around the world to reduce fossil fuel emissions ... significantly and quickly. 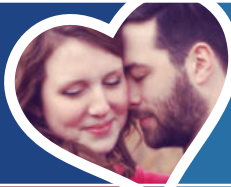
