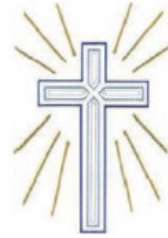

Our Adult Choir is always looking for new members. If you like to sing, check us out! Build friendships, make music and praise God!



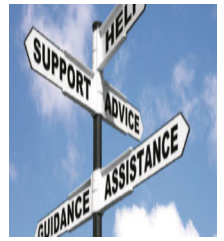

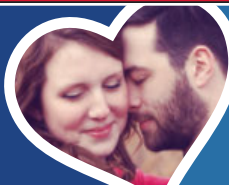
