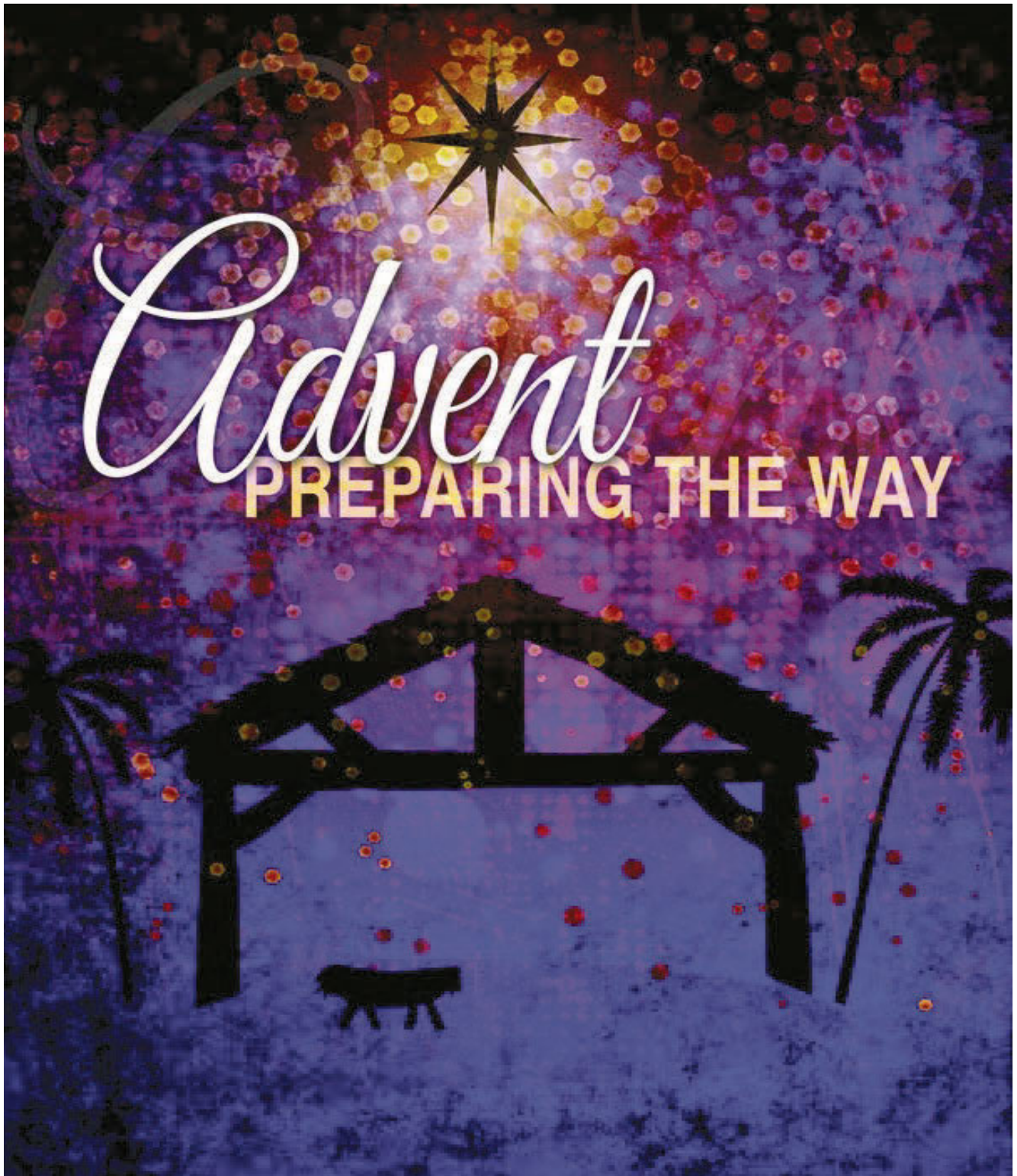


Sacred Heart Parish

My dear Parishioners, Sisters and Brothers,

The first Sunday of Advent begins the liturgical year once again. We re-start our journey towards God and with God. During Advent the Lord Jesus shows us some people whom we should follow. Let's look at their lives to learn something.

The first person is Mary, Mother of Jesus, our Mother. The Mother of God is for us a great example, but most of all - do not forget about it - she is our mother. Mary can help us in all difficulties. Talk to Mary, tell her about all your joys, problems, about everything. And ask her that in her prayer, she ask her Son, Jesus for many graces and strength.

Then, St. John the Baptist. He was the son of Elizabeth and Zechariah. Child prodigy, destined from birth to do great works, he was an ascetic, a man of sacrifice and prayer. John was a great moral authority, educator of the nation, the famous preacher calling for repentance. **And finally, St. Nicholas.** We know little about him. St. Nicholas lived a long time ago, in the early fourth century, about one thousand five hundred years ago. He was the Bishop of Myra (in Turkey) and became famous for his charity. Stories have been told and retold about him through the centuries. Perhaps we can utilize the lessons taught by his giving, look deeper at our approach to material goods in this Christmas season and find ways to extend our sharing to those in real need.

The holiness of John the Baptist is to be admired, but the sanctity of St. Nicholas is to follow. John was a good man, but still received an additional, difficult mission. The awakening of conscience and the goodness of his heart were hidden in a very harsh life. St. Nicholas did not have this additional calling. He was a bishop and he wanted to be a good shepherd of his people.

Let's look at our families. What does it mean to be a good wife, husband, child, mom, dad, grandma, grandpa? Is it a great challenge? This one is within reach of everyone.

Goodness depends only on us, no one else. Whoever wants to be good, can be, always and everywhere. We can say that the little we know is because of our teachers; we can say that we are poor because our parents left us little; we can say that we have bad luck at work; that we have poor health. But there is no defense for one who is not good to others.

So remember – in the Church we have Saints to admire and to follow. Everyone can imitate St. Nicholas. Kindness is the simplest and surest way to the kingdom of heaven.

I wish you all a wonderful Sunday rest and a great week. I remember you in my everyday prayers, and I ask you to pray for me too, please. May God reward you all the good that you do for Sacred Heart Parish.

Moi Drodzy Parafianie, Siostry i Bracia ,

Pierwsza niedziela Adwentu po raz kolejny rozpoczyna rok liturgiczny. Zaczynamy na nowo naszą podróż ku Bogu i z Bogiem. Podczas Adwentu Pan Jezus wskazuje na kilka osób, śladami których powinniśmy podążać.

Pierwszą osobą jest Maryja, Matka Jezusa, nasza Matka. Matka Boża jest dla nas wspaniałym przykładem, ale przede wszystkim – nie zapominajmy o tym – jest naszą matką. Maryja może nam pomóc we wszystkich trudnościach. Rozmawiaj z Maryją, mów jej o wszystkich swoich radościach, problemach, o wszystkim. I prosz ją, aby w swojej modlitwie prosiła swojego Syna, Jezusa, o wiele łask i siły Ida Ciebie.

Następnie św. Jan Chrzciciel. Był synem Elżbiety i Zachariasza. Cudowne dziecko, przeznaczone od urodzenia do wielkich dzieł. Jan był ascetą, człowiekiem poświęcenia i modlitwy. Był wielkim autorytetem moralnym, wychowawcą narodu, słynnym kaznodzieją wzywającym do pokuty. **I wreszcie św. Mikołaj.** O nim wiemy niewiele. Święty Mikołaj żył na początku IV wieku. Był biskupem Miry (obecnie Turcja) i zasłynął ze swojej dobroczynności. Przez wieki opowiadano o nim piękne historie. Mikołaj uczy nas podejścia do dóbr materialnych szczególnie w okresie Adwentu i Bożego Narodzenia, a także pomaga nam znaleźć sposoby na to jak najlepiej dzielić się z tymi, którzy naprawdę są w potrzebie.

Świętość Jana Chrzciciela jest godna podziwu, a świętość Mikołaja możemy naśladować. Jan był dobrym człowiekiem, ale także świętym od trudnych zadań. Przebudzenie sumienia i dobroć jego serca były ukryte w bardzo surowym życiu. Święty Mikołaj nie miał tego dodatkowego powołania. Był biskupem i chciał być dobrym pasterzem swojego ludu.

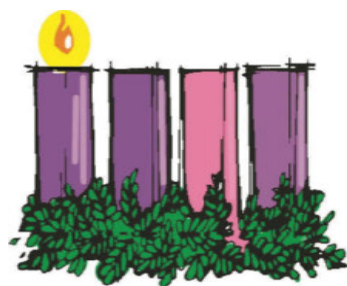
Przyjrzyjmy się naszym rodzinom. Co oznacza bycie dobrą żoną, mężem, dzieckiem, mamą, tatą, babcią, dziadkiem? Czy to wielkie wyzwanie? Nie, to jest w zasięgu każdego z nas. Dobroć zależy tylko od nas. Kto chce być dobry, może taki być, zawsze i wszędzie. Ktoś powie, że: niewiele wiem, ponieważ takich miałem nauczycieli; może powiedzieć, że jestem biedny, bo moi rodzice niewieli mi zostawili; może powiedzieć, że mam pecha w pracy; że mam gorsze zdrowie. Ale trudno znaleźć jakąś rozsądną wymówkę dla kogoś kto nie chce być dobrym dla innych.

Pamiętajmy – w Kościele mamy Świętych, których należy podziwiać i naśladować. Każdy może naśladować św. Mikołaja. Życzliwość jest najprostszą i najpewniejszą drogą do królestwa niebieskiego.

Życzę wam wszystkim wspaniałego niedzielnego odpoczynku i wspaniałego tygodnia. Pamiętam o was w moich codziennych modlitwach i proszę was, abyście modlili się również za mnie. Niech Bóg wynagrodzi wam całe dobro, które czynicie dla parafii Sacred Heart Parish.

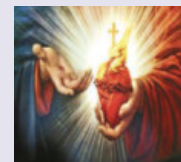

Teen Open Gym

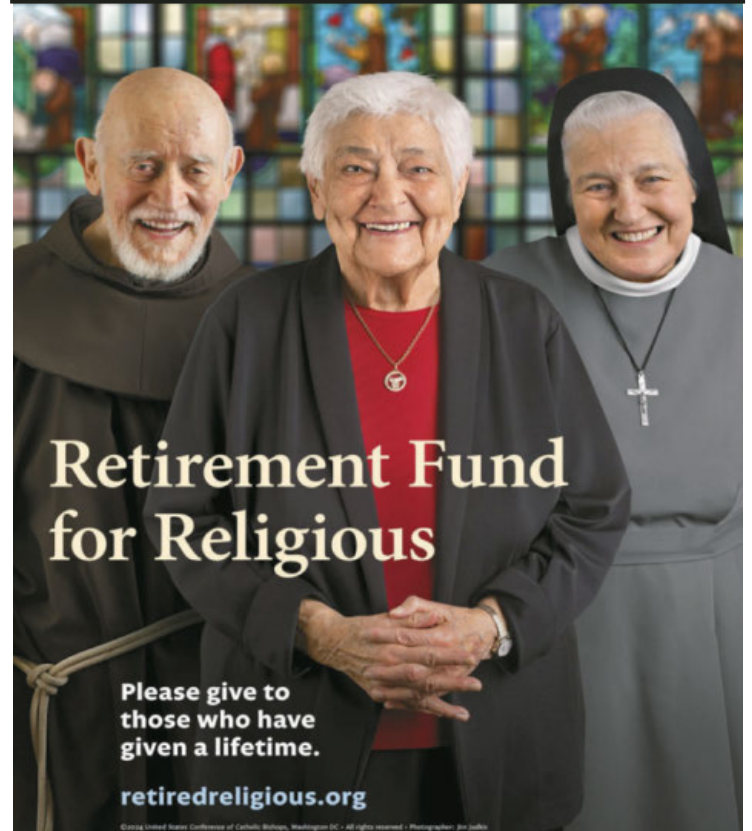

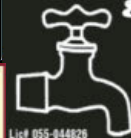

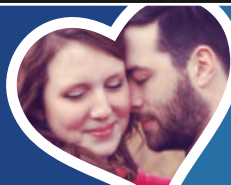
