SPES NON CONFUNDIT. “Hope does not disappoint” (Rom 5:5). In the spirit of hope, the Apostle Paul addressed these words of encouragement to the Christian community of Rome. Hope is also the central message of the coming Jubilee that, in accordance with an ancient tradition, the Pope proclaims every twenty-five years. (...) Everyone knows what it is to hope. In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring. (...) Taking it as our guide, let us return to the message that St. Paul wished to communicate to the Christians of Rome. (...)

Saint Paul is a realist. He knows that life has its joys and sorrows, that love is tested amid trials, and that hope can falter in the face of suffering. Even so, he can write: “We boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope” (Rom 5:3-4). For the Apostle, trials and tribulations mark the lives of those who preach the Gospel amid incomprehension and persecution (cf. 2 Cor 6:3-10). Yet in those very contexts, beyond the darkness we glimpse a light: we come to realize that evangelization is sustained by the power flowing from Christ’s cross and resurrection. In this way, we learn to practice a virtue closely linked to hope, namely patience. In our fast-paced world, we are used to wanting everything now. We no longer have time simply to be with others; even families find it hard to get together and enjoy one another’s company. Patience has been put to flight by frenetic haste, and this has proved detrimental, since it leads to impatience, anxiety and even gratuitous violence, resulting in more unhappiness and self-centeredness.

Nor is there much place for patience in this age of the Internet, as space and time yield to an ever present “now”. Were we still able to contemplate creation with a sense of awe, we might better understand the importance of patience. We could appreciate the changes of the seasons and their harvests, observe the life of animals and their cycles of growth, and enjoy the clarity of vision of Saint Francis. In his Canticle of the Creatures, written exactly eight hundred years ago, Francis saw all creation as a great family and could call the sun his “brother” and the moon his “sister”.

A renewed appreciation of the value of patience could only prove beneficial for ourselves and for others. Saint Paul often speaks of patience in the context of our need for perseverance and confident trust in God’s promises. Yet, before all else, he testifies to God’s own patience, as “the God of all patience and encouragement” (Rom 15:5). Patience, one of the fruits of the Holy Spirit, sustains our hope and strengthens it as a virtue and a way of life. May we learn to pray frequently for the grace of patience, which is both the daughter of hope and at the same time its firm foundation. (...)

„SPES NON CONFUNDIT”, „nadzieja zawieść nie może” (Rz 5, 5). W imię nadziei Paweł Apostoł napelnia odwagą chrześcijańską wspólnotę Rzymu. Nadzieja jest również głównym przesłaniem zbliżającego się Jubileusza, który zgodnie ze starożytną tradycją papież ogłasza co dwadzieścia pięć lat. (...)

Wszyscy mają nadzieję. Nadzieja jest obecna w sercu każdego człowieka jako pragnienie i oczekiwanie dobra, nawet jeśli nie wie, co przyniesie ze sobą jutro. (...) Pozwólmy, aby poprowadziło nas słowo, które Apostoł Paweł napisał właśnie do chrześcijan Rzymu. (...)

Paweł jest wielkim realistą. Wie, że życie składa się z radości i smutków, że miłość jest poddawana próbie, gdy wzrastają trudności, a nadzieja wydaje się załamywać w obliczu cierpienia. Mimo to pisze: „Chlubimy się także z ucisków, wiedząc, że ucisk wyrabia wytrwałość, a wytrwałość – wypróbowaną cnotę, wypróbowana zaś cnota – nadzieję” (Rz 5, 3-4). Dla Apostoła, ucisk i cierpienie są typowymi warunkami tych, którzy głoszą Ewangelię w kontekście niezrozumienia i prześladowań. Ale w takich sytuacjach, przez ciemność przebija się światło: odkrywamy, jak ewangelizacja podtrzymywana jest przez moc płynącą z krzyża i zmartwychwstania Chrystusa. A to prowadzi do rozwoju cnoty ściśle związanej z nadzieją: cierpliwości. Nawykliśmy już, by chcieć wszystkiego i natychmiast, w świecie, w którym pośpiech stał się czymś stałym. Nie mamy już czasu na spotkania, a często nawet w rodzinach trudno jest być razem i spokojnie porozmawiać. Cierpliwość została wygnana przez pośpiech, wyrządzając ludziom wielką krzywdę. Niecierpliwość, nerwowość, czasem nieuzasadniona przemoc biorą górę, rodząc niezadowolenie i zamknięcie.

Ponadto, w dobie internetu, gdzie przestrzeń i czas są wypierane przez „tu i teraz”, cierpliwość nie jest czymś zawsze obecnym w naszym domu. Gdybyśmy nadal byli w stanie patrzeć z zadziwieniem na stworzenie, moglibyśmy zrozumieć, jak bardzo decydujące znaczenie ma cierpliwość. Trzeba czekać na zmianę pór roku z ich owocami; obserwować życie zwierząt i cykle ich rozwoju; mieć proste oczy św. Franciszka, który w swojej Pieśni słonecznej, napisanej dokładnie 800 lat temu, postrzegał stworzenie jako jedną wielką rodzinę i nazywał słońce „bratem”, a księżyc „siostrą”. Odkrycie cierpliwości na nowo jest bardzo dobre dla nas samych i dla innych. Św. Paweł często odwołuje się do cierpliwości, aby podkreślić znaczenie wytrwałości i zaufania do tego, co Bóg nam obiecał, ale przede wszystkim świadczy o tym, że Bóg jest cierpliwy wobec nas, On jest „Bogiem, który daje cierpliwość i pociechę” (Rz 15, 5). Cierpliwość, będąca również owocem Ducha Świętego, podtrzymuje nadzieję i umacnia ją jako cnotę i sposób życia. Dlatego uczmy się często prosić o łaskę cierpliwości, która jest córką nadziei i jednocześnie ją wspiera.
