Ordinary Operating Income for fiscal years ending in 2023 and 2024.

Our main source of ordinary income is our Sunday and Holy day collections including electronic giving.

These collections accounted for nearly 72% of all ordinary income in fiscal year ending in 2023 and nearly 74% of all ordinary income in fiscal year ending in 2024.

While additional income sources range from 4%-7% of our total operating income, they are important because just 5% is equal to \$51,630 when you are dealing with total ordinary income of \$1,032,600 as in fiscal year ending in 2023.

Ordinary Operating Expenses for fiscal year ending in 2023 and 2024.

Our main expenses, like most parishes and businesses, are salaries and benefits.

These expenses accounted for nearly 56% in fiscal year ending in 2023 and 55% in fiscal year ending in 2024.

The next largest expense is the Archdioceses' assessments which include the property, casualty and auto insurance. The assessments accounted for about 17% a year of our ordinary operating expenses in both fiscal years.

The rest of our ordinary expenses, account for 4%-10% of the total, in both fiscal years.

Extraordinary operating income for fiscal year's ending in 2023 and 2024.

Extraordinary operating income includes some income that occurs yearly and some income that don't. For example: notice that in fiscal year ending in 2023, our parish received a Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan forgiveness of \$134,007 while in the following year there was none.

On the other hand, examples of a reoccurring extraordinary income are BINGO, PULL-TAB AND SPLIT THE POT. For fiscal year 2023, this accounted for 34% of all extraordinary income, while in 2024 it accounted for a whopping 60% of all extraordinary income.

Extraordinary operation expenses for fiscal years ending in 2023 and 2024.

Extraordinary expenses include a number of items, but the majority fall in the category of a Capital Improvement or a repair to our beautiful campus.

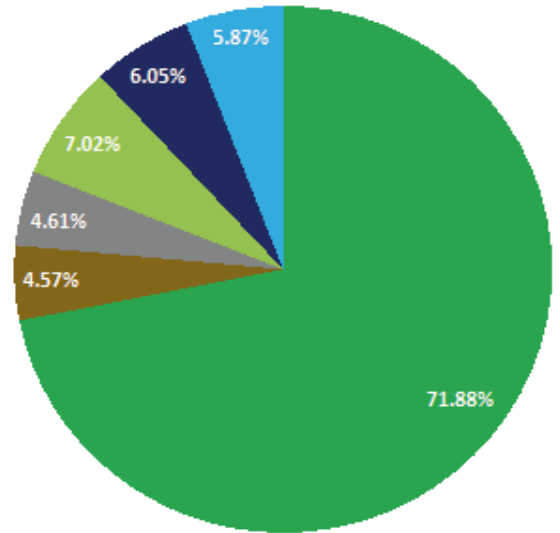
When reading the report notice how from the New AC unit for the church and each line item through the Other Repairs and Updates, these expenses accounted for 72% in the fiscal year ending in 2023 and nearly 84% in the fiscal year ending in 2024.

So, please continue to fund our Sacred Heart Capital Improvement Fund.

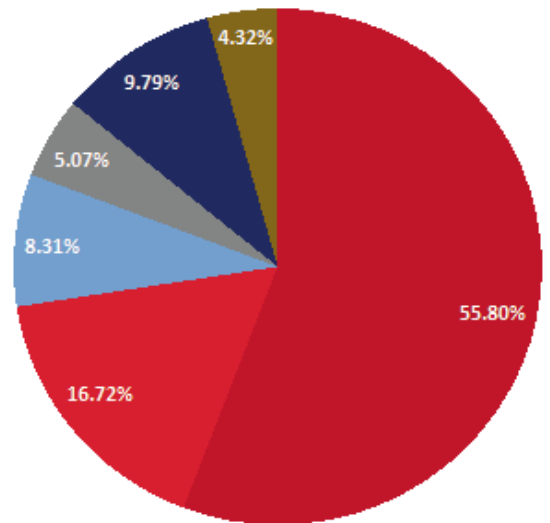

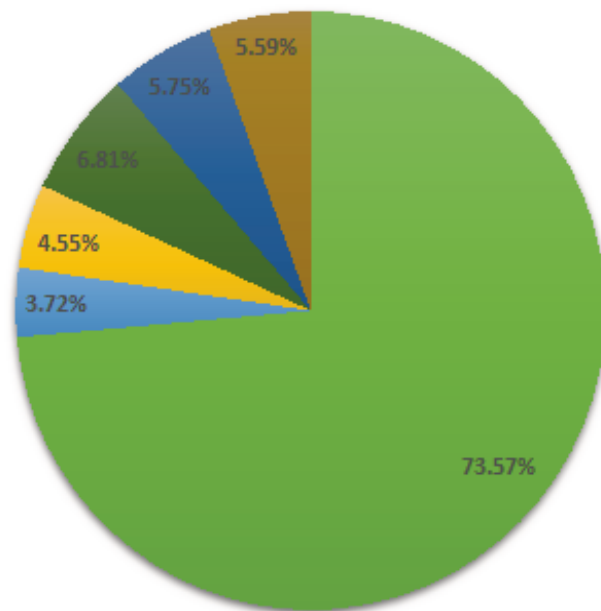


Net Operating Loss -\$26,928

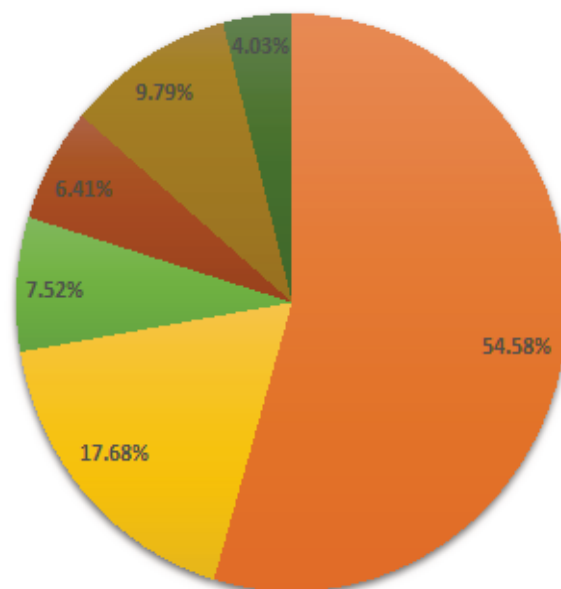

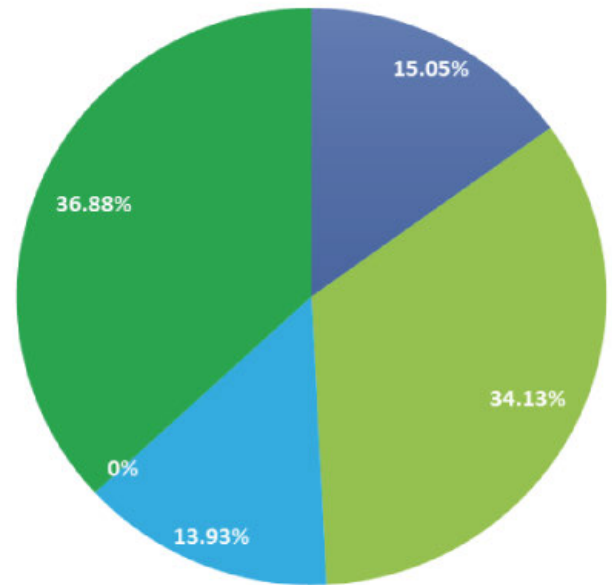


Net Operating Loss -\$101,582

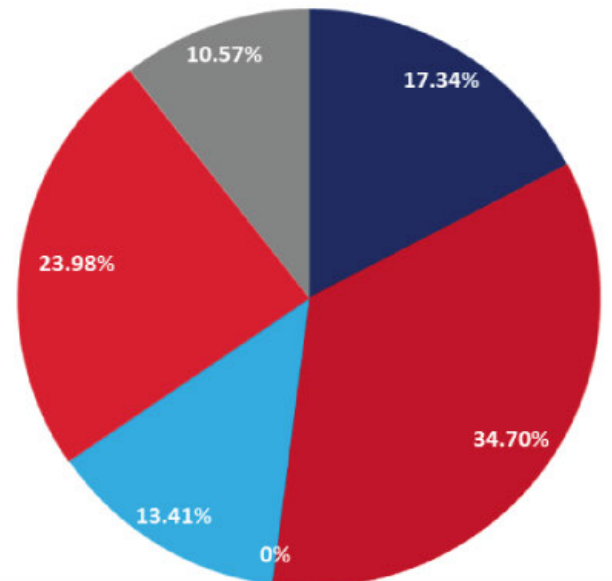

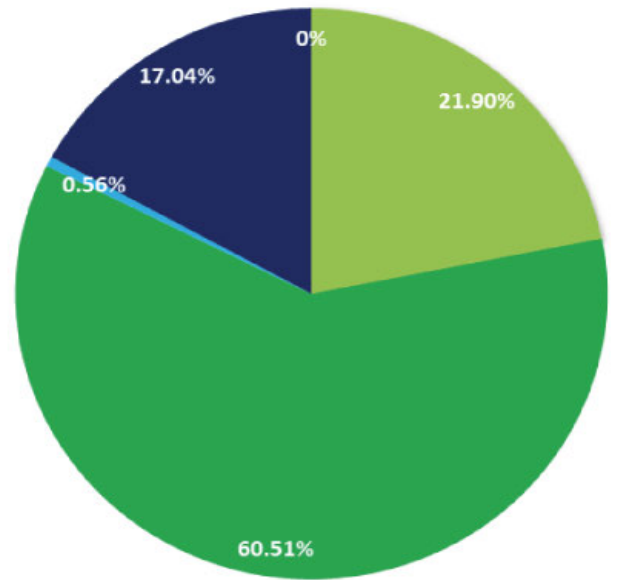

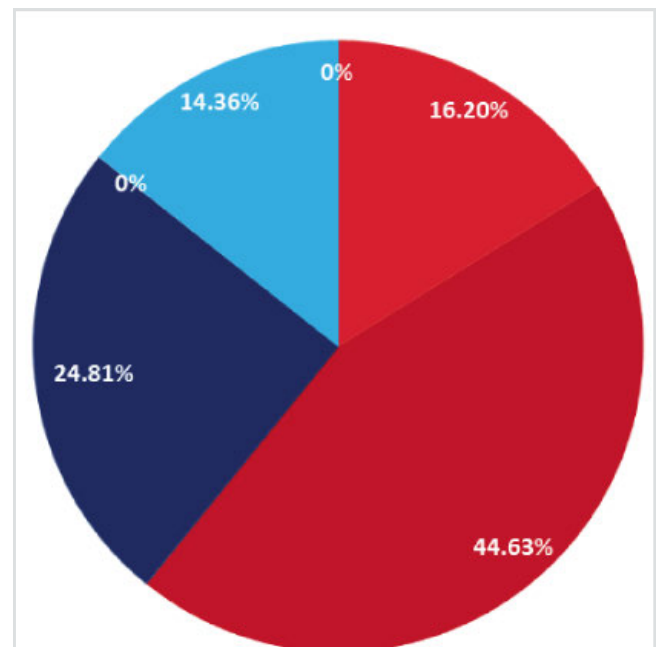

YEAR-END TAX STATEMENTS FOR 2024

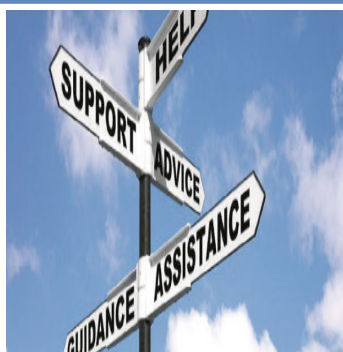
In years past, we have automatically sent out year-end tax statements for anyone who contributed over \$250.

Creation Care Corner

Laudate Deum - Individual and Systemic Change

Pope Francis once again urges the world to take action to reduce the impact of climate change in his recent Apostolic Exhortation *Laudate Deum*. A key concern of his is that climate change is especially harmful to the poor and future generations. As individuals we can and should take actions like switching to a more plant-based diet, flying and driving less, and adjusting the thermostat, etc.. But Francis notes that much of the problem is systemic, i.e.: the carbon pollution that is baked into existing systems of electricity generation, transportation, agriculture and building construction. So, in addition to taking personal action, we must find ways to engage our government officials and encourage them to address those systemic contributors to the climate issue. We can do this by writing our Congressional Representatives or by joining or supporting groups that do so.

As Christians we should meditate on the questions: What am I doing for Christ? What ought I do for Christ? Consequently, if the discipleship of Jesus Christ includes care for creation and concern for humans suffering, including suffering from the results of climate change, we ought to ask: What am I doing to care for creation? What ought I do to Care for Creation?

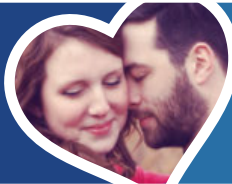
