## Doroczna Kwesta Katolicka 2025

### Razem niesiemy nadzieję

W przyszłym tygodniu odbędzie się Niedziela Zobowiązań na rzecz Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej 2025. Tegoroczny temat Kwesty, to Razem niesiemy nadzieję. Temat nawiązuje do synodu o synodalności i do jego przesłania, jakim jest wspólne podążanie drogą wiary. Nawiązuje on również do tematu Roku Świętego — Pielgrzymi nadziei. Wreszcie, rezonuje z naszymi wysiłkami na rzecz odnowy i transformacji w Archidiecezji Chicago.

Ty i ja jesteśmy naśladowcami Jezusa. Idziemy Jego śladami. Powinniśmy robić to, co On. Tak więc razem, tak jak On, niesiemy nadzieję światu, który jest tak bardzo zrozpaczony i tak bardzo potrzebuje nadziei. Czynimy to poprzez nasze słowa, gesty służby i osobiste wsparcie.

Razem niesiemy również nadzieję poprzez nasz udział w Dorocznej Kwestie Katolickiej. Od czasu rozpoczęcia Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej w 1991 roku, hojni mieszkańcy Archidiecezji Chicago wsparli swoich sąsiadów lokalnie i na całym świecie 2,2 milionami darówizn o łącznej wartości blisko 390 milionów dolarów. Jest ona ważnym narzędziem niesienia nadziei, zwłaszcza ludziom żyjącym na obrzeżach społecznych.

Dzięki Kwestie możemy nieść nadzieję i wspierać parafie w potrzebie, szkoły katolickie, programy edukacji religijnej oraz archidiecezjalne inicjatywy na rzecz poszanowania życia, pokoju, zapobiegania przemocy i szkolenia liderów w naszych wspólnotach wiary. W perspektywie udzielania pomocy potrzebującym na świecie, Kwesta wspiera Katolicką Organizację Niesienia Pomocy, która pomaga ofiarom wojen i klęsk żywiołowych.

Proszę, abyś w ciągu najbliższego tygodnia, zastanowił się, pomodlił i zapytał siebie samego, jak Ty możesz pomóc, aby nieść nadzieję innym. Rozważ, na tyle, na ile możesz konkretnie i szczegółowo, w jaki sposób twój wkład w postaci Twojego czasu, zdolności, umiejętności i zasobów pomoże ci w tym. Przygotuj się do podjęcia zobowiązania w przyszłym tygodniu.

### HOLY NAME SOCIETY AND CCW

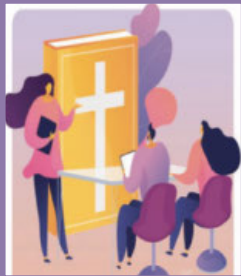

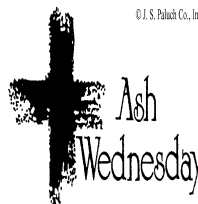

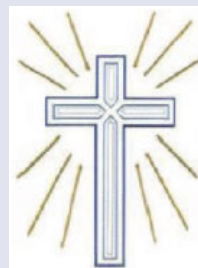

### THIS WEEK’S STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION:

**Lent is coming.** Consider a “fast” for Creation Care ... sacrificing some comfort, giving up a wasteful practice, or modifying your actions to reduce harm to the environment. Some ideas include:

- **A Meat Fast:** How about adding a meatless Monday to meatless Fridays? What about eating only chicken when you do eat meat, or sustainably caught fish?
- **An Energy Fast:** How about turning the thermostat down 2-5°F lower than usual and putting that sweater on? And maybe turn the water heater down to 120°F and only take 3-minute showers?
- **A “Stuff” Fast:** Buying only the bare minimum of essentials you need and simplifying your life? And how about staying away from as much plastic as you can and minimizing your waste stream?

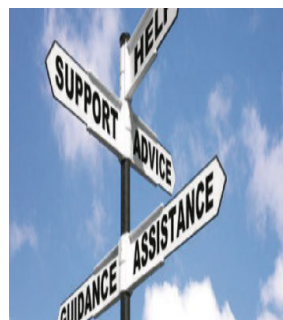

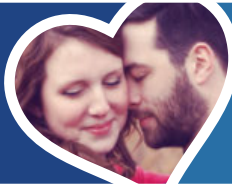
