

**DOROCZNA KWESTA  
KATOLICKA 2025  
WEEKEND ZOBOWIĄZAŃ:  
22–23 LUTEGO**

Tegoroczny temat Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej to Razem niesiemy nadzieję. Słowa te nawiązują do tematu Roku Świętego: Pielgrzymi Nadziei. Odnosi się również do naszych wysiłków na rzecz odnowy w Archidiecezji Chicago. Wpłaty na rzecz Kwesty są skutecznym sposobem na niesienie nadziei naszemu światu, zwłaszcza tym, którzy jej najbardziej potrzebują. Wspieranie Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej jednoczy nas jako Kościół Pański w okazywaniu miłości bliźniego poprzez dobre dzieła, których jesteśmy w stanie wspólnie dokonywać. Kwesta dodaje nam zapału w realizacji świętej misji naszej Archidiecezji do nauczania, służenia i uświęcania, pozwalając nam pełnić dzieło Chrystusa.

Proszę Was o znalezienie czasu w tym tygodniu na refleksję nad materiałami Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej, które powinniście otrzymać pocztą lub, które znajdują się w biuletynie. Prosimy, abyście pamiętali, że Doroczna Kwesta Katolicka jest czymś zupełnie innym niż jednorazową specjalną kolektą. Jest to kampania, podczas której składane są zobowiązania finansowe, które mogą być spłacane w ratach. Każde zobowiązanie ma znaczenie! Wszystkie parafie archidiecezji uczestniczą w Kweście i to dzięki darom złożonym przez wiele osób archidiecezja może udzielać pomocy duszpasterskiej i świadczyć potrzebne usługi oraz wyciągać pomocną dłoń na cały świat za pośrednictwem Katolickiej Organizacji Niesienia Pomocy. 

### Getting Ready for Lent



The Church knows from centuries of experience that we really don't start getting into Lent until we receive ashes on our forehead on **Ash Wednesday**.

The next three days—the Thursday, Friday and Saturday after Ash Wednesday—are a time for us to start “warming up” for Lent. These days are something like “pre-season games” in most sports. We start our Lenten practices, but we’re getting the feel of it, and making our plans. Then, with the first full week of Lent we’re into it with full force. The 40 days of Lent are measured from the First Sunday of Lent until Holy Thursday, then we begin the “Triduum” — the three holiest days of the year: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.



*For their own safety, keep their whereabouts or activities off of social media.*

**DON'T** give up!

*Keep the lines of communication open and stay patient. You might be the only person they've confided in.*
