**My dear Parishioners,**  
**Brothers and Sisters,**

On Ash Wednesday, we will receive ashes in the form of a cross. This ritual dramatizes the purpose of the forty days of Lent, which is to unite ourselves with Jesus in His Passion, Death and Resurrection. The question is: *How does a person make a "good Lent"? What will I do differently during these six weeks?*

Three key pillars characterize the period of Lent: prayer, fasting and almsgiving (charity).

The USCCB tells us that during Lent, “we seek the Lord in prayer, reading the Holy Scriptures; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting.”

While most Catholics are familiar with the “ban on meat on Fridays” during Lent, **fasting and abstinence** are important elements throughout Lent. This may mean giving up gossip, your favorite coffee or car music and replacing it with prayer.

**Almsgiving** reminds us of Jesus’ call to service and unites us in solidarity with our brothers and sisters in need.

And finally: **prayer**. And here I recommend the Hallow App. It offers a wonderful selection of prayer resources for every stage of your Lenten journey.

I wish you all a wonderful Sunday rest. I remember you in my everyday prayers and I ask: pray for me and other priests too, please. May God reward you all the good that you do for Sacred Heart Parish.

**Drodzy Parafianie, Siostry i Bracia,**

We Środę Popielcową przyjęliśmy na nasze czoła popiół – znak... I teraz od nas zależy czy ten symbol pozostanie tylko nie znaczącym symbolem czy stanie się czymś więcej. Co roku zadajemy sobie pytanie: *Jak zrobić, żeby to był dobry Wielki Post? Co mogę zrobić innego podczas tych sześciu tygodni?*

Trzy kluczowe filary charakteryzują okres Wielkiego Postu: modlitwa, post i jałmużna (dobroczynność).

USCCB czyli Konferencja Biskupów amerykańskich wskazuje nam, że podczas Wielkiego Postu „szukamy Pana w modlitwie, czytając Pismo Święte; służymy, dając jałmużnę; oraz ćwiczymy samokontrolę poprzez post”.

Podczas gdy większość katolików jest zaznajomiona z „zakazem spożywania mięsa w piątki” w okresie Wielkiego Postu, **post i abstynencja** są ważnymi elementami przez cały Wielki Post. Może to oznaczać rezygnację z czegoś więcej np: plotek, ulubionej kawy lub muzyki w samochodzie i zastąpienie jej modlitwą. Czyli oznacza pracę nad sobą.

**Jałmużna** przypomina nam o wezwaniu Jezusa do służby i łączy nas w solidarności z naszymi braćmi i siostrami w potrzebie.

I wreszcie: **modlitwa**. I tutaj np polecam aplikację Hallow, która oferuje wspaniały zestaw materiałów modlitewnych na każdy etap czasu Wielkiego Postu.

Życzę wszystkim dobrego niedzielnego wypoczynku. Pamiętam o Was moich modlitwach – proszę módlcie się też za nas pracujących w parafii. Niech Bóg wynagrodzi wszelkie dobro, którym wspomagacie parafię Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa.

### POST ŚCISŁY W ŚRODĘ POPIELCOWĄ

Zgodnie z kanonami 1251-1252 Kodeksu Prawa Kanonicznego w Środę Popielcową obowiązuje wstrzemięźliwość (nie spożywa się pokarmów mięsnych) i post ścisły (ilościowy – ograniczenie się do spożycia 3 posiłków: dwóch lekkich i jednego do syta). Prawem o wstrzemięźliwości są związani wszyscy powyżej 14. roku życia, a prawem o poście – pełnoletni od ukończenia 18 roku życia do rozpoczęcia 60 roku życia.

Post ilościowy polega na spożyciu w ciągu dnia tylko jednego posiłku do syta oraz lekkiego posiłku rano i wieczorem. Post ilościowy i jakościowy obowiązuje tylko dwa dni w ciągu roku, to jest w Środę Popielcową i w Wielki Piątek. Obowiązuje on wiernych od ukończenia 18 roku życia do rozpoczęcia 60 roku życia.

### ASH WEDNESDAY FASTING

According to canons 1251-1252 of the Code of Canon Law, Ash Wednesday requires abstinence (no consumption of meat) and fasting (quantitative—limiting oneself to three meals: two light meals and one substantial meal). The law of abstinence applies to all individuals above the age of 14, while the law of fasting applies to adults from the age of 18 until the beginning of the 60th year of life.

Quantitative fasting involves consuming only one substantial meal during the day, with light meals in the morning and evening. Both quantitative and qualitative fasting apply only on two days of the year: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. They are obligatory for those who have reached the age of 18 until the beginning of the 60th year of life.

Many times in the Gospels, Jesus is walking and showing us the way. Why not walk with him? This Lent, we invite you to walk with Jesus – all the way to Jerusalem!

It is approximately 6,200 miles from Palos Hills to Jerusalem which is about 12,400,000 steps. Alone, this would be impossible but together, we can do great things. Walk with Jesus and be his companion on his journey. At the same time, we can be companions to each other by praying as we walk.

This is the plan: Walk and keep track of your steps. There are about 2,000 steps in a mile which would take on average, 20 minutes. Every week, there will be slips of paper for you to fill out how many steps you walked, or how many minutes you walked. We will collect the slips and track our accomplishments on a map that will be in the Narthex. Also, we will have paper footsteps on which you can write the name of a person or intention you carried in prayer on your walk. We will keep these on the altar and remember your intentions at every Mass.

Walking is good for us! Let's join Jesus on his walk to Jerusalem this Lent so that together we can join in his Resurrection at Easter.

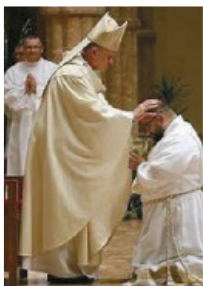

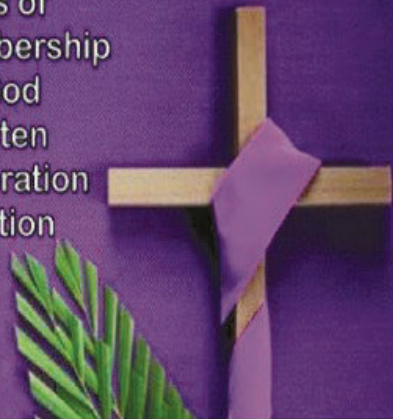
