

## ANSWER THE CALL TO SPIRITUALLY RENEW OUR PARISHES

The third component of the *Generation to Generation* campaign is raising \$60 million to spiritually renew our parishes. A relationship with Jesus Christ is the most relevant relationship we have in finding meaning to life. These days, however, a majority of our younger generations did not grow up with active faith practice. We can no longer wait for them to come to us. We must seek them out.

Our renewal efforts will focus on walking with people across a path of Christian discipleship and will develop in two ways: Renewal support and formation for parishes and outreach for people exploring faith. Key areas of parish focus include building up parish leaders, offering Christ-centered entry points, building capacity for individual faith accompaniment, establishing small faith communities within the parish, fostering opportunities for spiritual encounter, and enabling faith witness. Additionally, the archdiocese will create tailored online workshops and curated content, hosted on a digital platform, that will invite those that are spiritually hungry.

#### My dear Parishioners, Brothers and Sisters,

We begin **Holy Week.** Today Jesus Christ enters triumphantly to Jerusalem. The crowds welcome Him; people with tears in their eyes and hope in their hearts greet their Lord and King. But the question is: Was this royal greeting sincere? We will get the answer on Good Friday.

**Holy Thursday** begins the Paschal Triduum. On Holy Thursday Jesus established two sacraments, the Eucharist and the sacrament of Holy Orders. These two sacraments are very important for the life of the Church. These two sacraments are very close to each other, indeed inseparable. The Eucharist is the sacrament that unites the Church with Christ. And Christ is present in the Eucharist through the Holy Sacrifice celebrated by every Catholic priest.

Mass of the Lord's Supper will be at 7:00 pm (bilingual).

Good Friday – the Day of the Passion and Death of Jesus Christ. This is the only day in the year when the Holy Mass is not celebrated. And on Good Friday we get an answer to the question which we asked earlier – Was the royal greeting on Palm Sunday sincere? The answer came during Pilate's vote. So when they had assembled, Pilate said to them, "Which one do you want me to release to you, Barabbas, or Jesus called Christ?" They answered, "Barabbas!" Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Jesus called Christ?" They all said,



"Let him be crucified!" And Jesus lost... The Truth is once again received and renounced – slapped down! But Jesus was right, because He is the one who conquers the world, though He lost the human plebiscite.

Let us be aware of our choices, our decisions. Let us remember that this is our responsibility before God and men.

On Good Friday at 3:30 pm the Piano/Guitar Ensemble and parish teens will present Family Stations of the Cross. And of course, I would like to strongly encourage you not to forget about the beautiful evening Good Friday liturgy. During this liturgy, we will listen to the Passion and Death of Jesus. And later, we will venerate The Cross, the Sign of our salvation. We will kiss it and with the greatest respect we will cry over the sufferings of Christ.

The Liturgy of Good Friday will be at 6:00 pm in English and at 8:00 pm in Polish.

**Holy Saturday** is a day of silence. The Good Shepherd passed away. The stone is set aside at the tomb and the waiting time for the Resurrection begins. Those are the hours of prayer, silence and watch. In the Holy Saturday morning and noon hours we will bless the food and in the evening at 7:00 pm we will participate in the beautiful liturgy of the Easter Vigil.

I'd like to ask you again to remember our Sacred Heart Parish during these last days of Lent and Easter. Special Easter gifts are a very big financial support for our parish. I know that I can count on all of you. And for that, from the bottom of my heart I thank you! May God reward you for all your kindness and generosity. I want to assure you also that nothing will be wasted.

I offer my heartfelt thanks to you for all that you do for Sacred Heart Parish, for your sacrifice and support. I remember you in my everyday prayers, and I ask you to pray for me too, please. May God reward you with His blessing and graces!

#### Drodzy Parafianie, Bracia i Siostry,

Rozpoczynamy Wielki Tydzień. Dzisiaj Jezus Chrystus triumfalnie wkracza do Jerozolimy. Witają Go tłumy; ludzie ze łzami w oczach i nadzieją w sercach witają swego Pana i Króla. Ale jednak rodzi się pytanie: czy to królewskie powitanie było szczere? Na to pytanie odpowiedź przyjdzie w Wielki Piątek.

Wielki Czwartek rozpoczyna Triduum Paschalne. W ten dzień Pan Jezus ustanowił dwa sakramenty: Eucharystię i sakrament święceń kapłańskich. Te dwa sakramenty są bardzo ważne dla życia Kościoła; są bardzo blisko siebie, a nawet nierozłaczne. Eucharystia jest sakramentem, który jednoczy Kościół z Chrystusem. Chrystus jest obecny w Eucharystii poprzez Świętą Ofiarę celebrowaną przez każdego katolickiego ksiedza. Dwujezyczna Msza Św. Wieczerzy Pańskiej rozpocznie się o 7:00 wieczorem.

Wielki Piątek – dzień męki i śmierci Jezusa Chrystusa. To jedyny dzień w roku, w którym nie jest odprawiana Msza Święta. A w Wielki Piątek otrzymujemy odpowiedź na pytanie, które zadaliśmy wcześniej – czy królewskie powitanie w Niedzielę Palmowa było szczere? Odpowiedź przyszła podczas głosowania zarządzonego przez Piłata. A gdy się zgromadzili, rzekł do nich Piłat: Którego chcecie, abym wam uwolnił, Barabasza, czy Jezusa, zwanego Chrystusem? Odpowiedzieli: "Barabasza!" Piłat rzekł do nich: Cóż więc mam uczynić z Jezusem, którego zowią Chrystusem? Wszyscy powiedzieli: "Niech będzie ukrzyżowany!" I tak



Jezus przegrał... Prawda została ponownie przyjęta i odrzucona – a nawet spoliczkowana! Ale to Jezus miał rację, ponieważ On jest tym, który zwycięża świat, nawet mimo tego, że przegrał ten haniebny ludzki plebiscyt.

Bądźmy świadomi naszych wyborów, naszych decyzji. Pamiętajmy, że to jest nasza odpowiedzialność przed Bogiem i ludźmi.

W Wielki Piątek Zespół Muzyczny (Piano/Guitar Ensemble) poprowadzi Rodzinną Drogę Krzyżowa o 3:30PM w języku angielskim. Ale oczywiście przypominam o pięknej liturgii Wielkiego Piątku, podczas której będziemy słuchać opisu Męki i Śmierci Pana Jezusa, a następnie oddamy cześć Krzyżowi, który jest znakiem naszego zbawienia. Nasz pocałunek będzie także naszym płaczem nad cierpieniami Chrystusa. A później w procesji odprowadzimy Pana Jezusa do symbolicznego grobu.

Liturgia Wielkiego Piątku odbędzie się o 6:00PM w języku angielskim i o 8:00PM w języku polskim.

Wielka Sobota to dzień ciszy. Dobry Pasterz zmarł. Grób zasłonił ogromny kamień i rozpoczyna się czas oczekiwania na Zmartwychwstanie. Przed nami godziny modlitwy, ciszy i czuwania. W Wielką Sobotę przedpołudniem bedziemy błogosławić pokarmy oraz modlić się przy Grobie Pańskim, a wieczorem będziemy uczestniczyć w przepięknej liturgii Wigilii Paschalnej, która rozpocznie się o 7:00 pm.

W Niedzielę Zmartwychwstania Pańskiego zapraszam serdecznie na poranną Mszę Św. z procesją rezurekcyjną. Rozpoczniemy ją o godz. 5:30 rano. Zapraszam poczty sztandarowe kół i organizacji Polonijnych, a także Was Drodzy parafianie w strojach regionalnych.

Chciałbym Was serdecznie prosić, abyście pamiętali o parafii Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa w tych dniach Wielkiego Postu i w czasie świąt Wielkiejnocy. ## **GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION**


We are in need of volunteers for our various liturgical ministries. These include: Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Ministers of Care, Ushers,




# Join Us for Divine Mercy Sunday, April 27, 2025

Sacred Heart will have a special Holy Hour for the "Feast of Mercy" on Sunday, April 27th.

The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of St. Faustina Kowalska from Poland. Our Lord appeared to Sister Faustina in a vision and told her to paint the now famous image of Divine Mercy. Our Lord requested that the Feast of Mercy be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. St. Faustina was the first saint canonized by Pope John Paul II in the new millennium.

The Sacred Heart Queen of Peace prayer group will be sponsoring a Holy Hour on the Feast of Mercy again this year. The preparations begin on **Good Friday, April 18th**, with the special Divine Mercy novena. Red novena prayer cards can be found at the back of church. Please pray the novena for nine consecutive days to obtain mercy for yourselves and for the whole world. The novena ends with the Feast Day on Sunday. The Lord promised special graces to all who keep this special Feast of Mercy: "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion **shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment**. On that day are open all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet."




